### Henry C. Lytton Is Again in Charge of The Hub in Chicago

In relating the development of the business from a small store, 50 by 100 feet on the northwest corner of State and Jackson streets, nearly a half century ago, Mr. Lytton discussed the era of combination and mergers which engulfed his firm, as it did others in this country when "billion dollar businesses" was the goal of many.

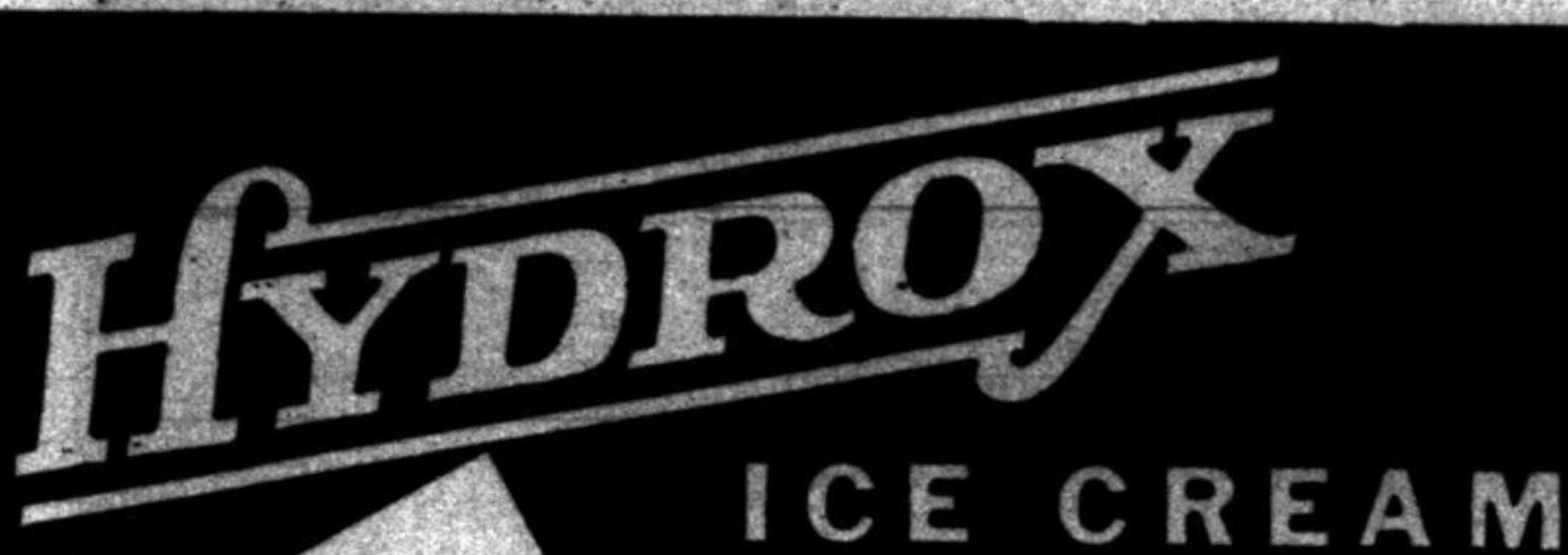
