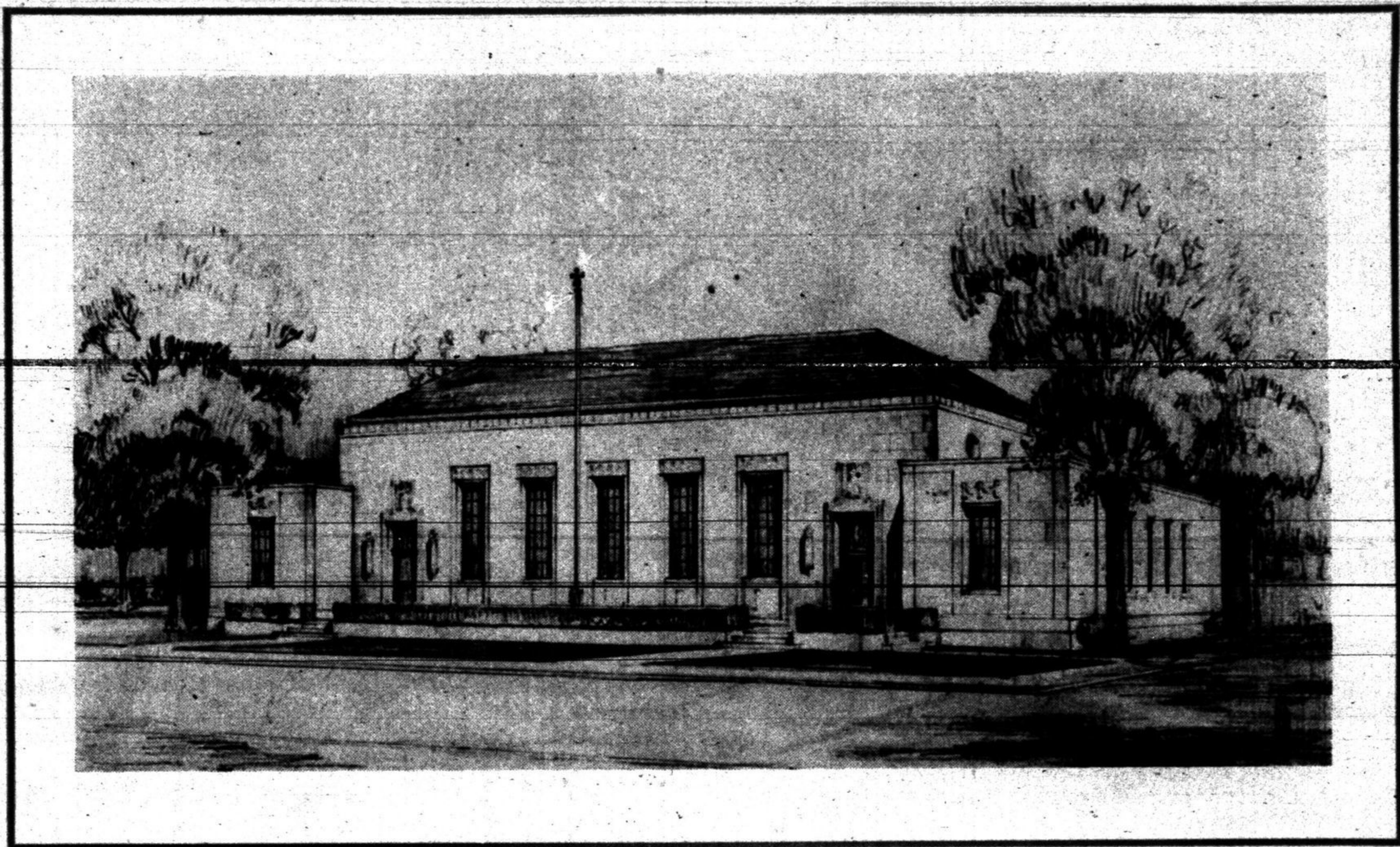


THE HIGHLAND PARK PRESS
