with Drag" May Lose  
Low License Numbers**

Numerous holders of low and unusual state automobile license plates in Lake Forest, Highland Park and other north shore towns run chances of losing their "pet" numbers if the numbering system is revised, as is being urged upon the new secretary of state, Edward J. Hughes, who takes office next month.

Mr. Hughes has been asked to endorse proposals to use letters of the alphabet as well as numbers on the plates so as to reduce the digits, and he has also been asked to approve proposals to issue certain groups of plates to each county so the police can readily identify a resident from a non-resident.

**Declines To Comment**

Any change in the system would require an act of the legislature, but the lawmakers would give considerable weight to a recommendation from the secretary of state. Mr. Hughes has declined to comment before taking office.

The issuance of favored numbers by the secretary of state has been a form of patronage since the license law was enacted. Once a number has been issued, the statute permits the holder to retain the number from year to year providing application for renewal is filed by Dec. 1.

The most common request made of the secretary is for low numbers. A directory of the first thousand numbers includes the names of politicians, both big and small, influential civic, commercial and social leaders, campaign contributors, and others best described as "folks with a drag."
