**World's Fair Traffic  
Flow to Be West of  
North Shore Drives**

The effort of the North Shore Property Owners association to prevent the routing of through traffic on Sheridan road is about to succeed, according to L. W. Beeman, secretary of that association.  
Arlington C. Harvey, of Evanston; Gordon L. Pirie of Hubbard Woods; and L. W. Beman have had several conferences with the committee of "A Century of Progress," headed by Maj. E. S. Irvine.  
The North Shore Property Owners association also has the backing of the following north shore village and city officials in this effort: Village Manager George R. Young of Glencoe, Mayor Albert D. Farwell of Lake Forest, President C. P. Dubbs of Wilmette, Mayor Charles H. Bartlett of Evanston, President William B. Moulton of Winnetka, President Ralph R. Haxhurst of Kenilworth.

The objections which "A Century of Progress" believes are reasonable are as follows:  
1. The two lane road in Hubbard Hill ravine and at the north end of Sheridan road would dam up traffic for miles and cause great hardship to the visitors.  
2. Sheridan road runs through the heart of a large group of towns. At the time of the Fair, the cross traffic is at its peak load.  
3. Five hundred private driveways enter Sheridan road and it has a hundred and fifty curves and corners, and a hundred intersections. Many of the intersections are obstructed by dense shrubbery.  
4. The erection of markers every hundred feet would cause intense bitterness in the communities that have been fighting to have all markers removed.

President William Sherman Hay of the North Shore Property Owners association announced that the membership committees for the north shore towns are organized and starting to work this week. The chairmen are as follows:  
Herman C. Hintzpeter, general chairman; John Griffith, Lake Forest; George W. Childs, Highland Park; James C. Younglove, Glencoe; Warren A. Lamson, Hubbard Woods; Edgar Crilly, Winnetka; Herman C. Hintzpeter, Kenilworth; Don F. Wiley, Wilmette; Robert L. Scott, Evanston.

The office of the association is at 120 South LaSalle street. The association is unanimously opposed to the building of an outer drive in Lake Michigan. They feel that it would spoil the skyline and bathing of all north shore towns, decrease property values, and this extravagant use of tax payers money would seriously increase taxes.

With the roads being built to the west, an outer drive is felt to be unnecessary, as all through traffic, with the markers, can be diverted to the Skokie Valley.

The Citizens State bank of Glencoe, which closed last June, will soon pay the first 15 per cent dividend, after having paid in full all bills payable, and after reserving sufficient cash to pay all preferred claims.
