Ford Is Leader in 1932 Production

Despite virtual absence from the market for several months early in 1932 due to the introduction of new models, Ford led all competitors during the first ten months of the year in sales of commercial cars and trucks, according to an announcement today by Purnell and Wilson, local Ford dealers.

The statement, which was based upon official figures reported by the R. L. Polk company, showed that Ford, during this period, had registered a total of 57,991 units, or 36.1 per cent of the total of 160,582 units of all makes. This compared with 55,754, or 34.7 percent of the total, for the next make.

It also was pointed out that since Ford re-entered the market in the spring, Ford sales of commercial cars and trucks consistently have exceeded sales of other makes.
