

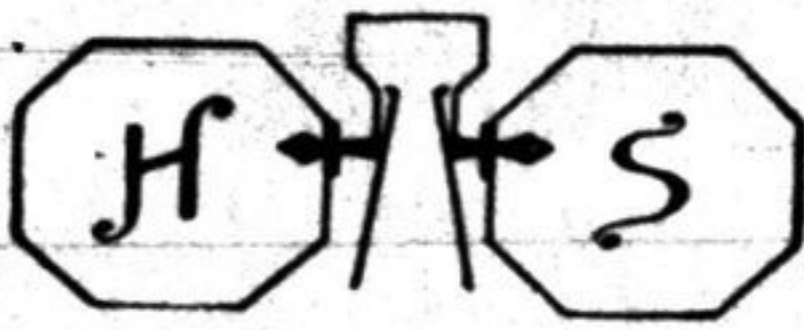

No Summer Session at the High School; Funds Are Tied Up

There will be no summer school at the Deerfield-Shields high school next summer, because of lack of funds, it was decided at a meeting of the board of education of the school Wednesday evening of last week. However, if numbers permit, the building will be made available for a pay school, all expenses to be met by the students.

A resolution was passed at the meeting of the board, accepting the suggestion of the teachers of nine and one-half month's pay for the full school year, rather than a nine-month school year with nine month's pay.

These changes were considered necessary because so much of the high school's money is involved in bank failures. About \$27,000 is tied up in the Waukegan State bank, over \$22,000 in the North Shore Trust company, of Highland Park, and over \$6,000 in the Highland State bank.

In addition, \$6,000 of student-activity funds is tied up in the North Shore Trust company. About thirty organizations had their money in this fund.

Winfred Glader Is Awarded the Budd Medal for Heroism

Winfred Glader of Highland Park, for his presence of mind and prompt action in an emergency, was recently honored by receiving the Britton I. Budd Medal for the saving of human life.

Three men were found unconscious in the cab of a truck by Judge F. E. Eldert of Northbrook, on the morning of March 22, 1932, just south of Techney on the Waukegan road. Judge Eldert and State Highway Officer Dewes removed them from the truck. Just then Mr. Glader and Mr. Nellesen, traveling south in a Public Service truck, came upon the scene.

They examined the three men all of whom were not breathing and apparently dead. Immediately they rolled the men over and began working the Schaefer prone pressure method of artificial respiration. Mr. Nellesen worked alternately on two of the men while Mr. Glader worked on the other.

Officer Dewes meanwhile drove to Willow road to get a gang of Public Service men he had seen working there. Dr. Rembie, who arrived in the meanwhile, urged the men to keep working. They were later relieved by the other Public Service men who worked as a team using oxygen mixture from an inhalator brought from the Public Service company's Northern Service headquarters.

After nearly two hours work, the men revived enough to be removed to a hospital where they all recovered by the next day.

This medal award was established by the Public Service company in 1926. Since that time employees of the company, all of whom are trained in the principles and application of first aid, have saved the lives of many people throughout northern Illinois. Thirty-seven medal awards have been made and before the creation of the medal numerous lives were saved of which there is no definite record.
