Alongside of the western boundary of the Century of Progress grounds, extending from 16th Street to 26th Street, is the Century parking area. Convenient overhead foot walks lead from the parking area to Fair ground entrances at 18th and 23rd Streets.

Responsible attendants are always on hand to watch and protect cars left in the parking area. There are two gasoline filling stations on the grounds. The grounds are well illuminated at night. The property belongs to the Illinois Central Railroad Company, and was leased by the Century Service Corporation.

Mr. Buhl has made plaques of several other prominent men, among them, Taft, Theodore Roosevelt, and Mayor Cermak. The first plaque of Cermak was molded while he was fighting death in a Florida hospital. This plaque was later sent to Mrs. Roosevelt, the wife of our President. A short time later Mr. Buhl received a letter of thanks from "The First Lady of the Land." In this letter Mrs. Roosevelt complimented Mr. Buhl on his ability and the remarkable resemblance to Mayor Cermak.

"A little later," said Mr. Buhl, "I am going to have them put on sale in the Fair grounds. The prices will be very low so as to enable a great number of people to obtain them. They are to be made in three colors, ivory, bronze and light oak. They will look very well on any wall in the home."
