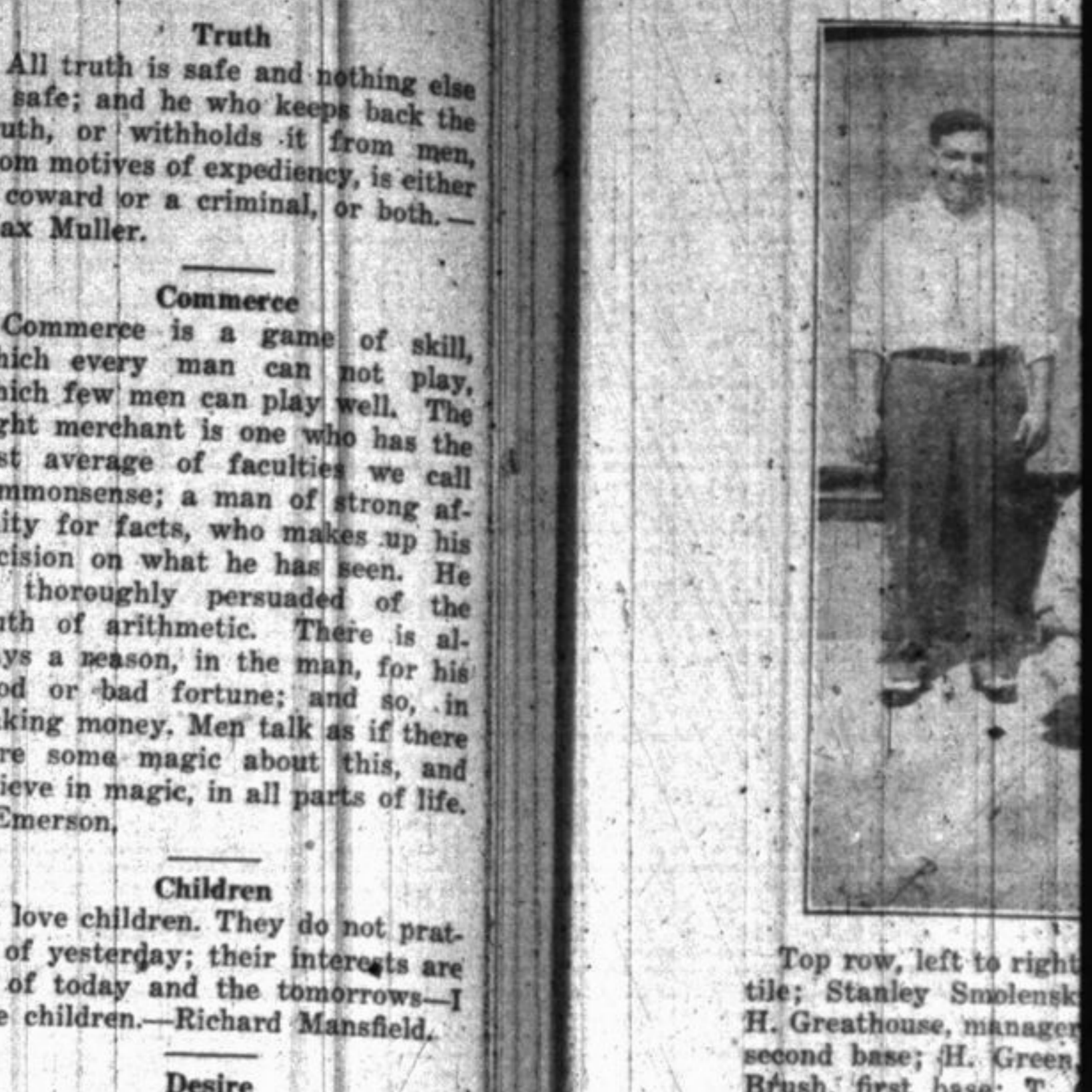

BONDHOLDERS FORM PROTECTIVE GROUP (Continued from page 1)

The situation will continue to become steadily worse unless some concerted action by the bondholders is taken," states the committee. "Bondholders' committees in other cities have worked to the mutual advantage of the bondholders themselves, the city officials, and the taxpayers. There are several ways of proceeding to enforce the obligation of special assessment bonds. It is possible to foreclose the lien of a special assessment bond against the real estate against which it is issued, just as a mortgage would be foreclosed. It is also possible to buy in the property at tax sale or to redeem forfeited property for the purpose of protecting the interests of the bondholders and to help them realize their investment. "There are over a million dollars worth of Highland Park special assessment issues outstanding in the hands of individuals and institutions," the committee states. "The holders are widely scattered. Without co-ordination, it was felt that it would be impossible to protect the interests of the bondholders. "The Highland Park State Bank has been named as depository. You are requested to forward your bonds promptly to the depository above named together with coupons attached, at the same time forwarding to the depository the letter (form may be secured from the committee) of the transmittal of said bonds. "On the last maturity date all but eight out of seventy-three Highland Park issues then outstanding, defaulted in some way. In some cases interest payments have been kept up but there have been principal defaults. However, the fact that principal defaults have occurred in these issues, and the tax payments are coming in so slowly, clearly shows that it would be to the best interests of the holders of subsequent bonds which have not yet defaulted, as well as the holders of those bonds which have defaulted, to deposit their bonds under this agreement at this time so that they can obtain the benefit of whatever proceedings are taken for the benefit of the maturities which have already defaulted. In other words, it is for the mutual benefit of all bondholders, whether the bonds they hold are already in default or not, to deposit their bonds under this agreement now and obtain the benefit of mutual co-operation. "Without the deposit of a substantial majority of all issues, at this time, the committee cannot proceed to take action and in such event the bonds deposited will be returned to the owners under the terms of the deposit agreement and you may suffer a considerable loss on your investment. "It is the hope of the committee to proceed so as not to harm any home owner who is doing all he can to meet his obligations and to pay the special assessments against his property. It is, of course, a fact that some people are unable to pay their special assessments at this time; it is also a fact that many others are taking advantage of their knowledge that no one is protecting the interests of the bondholders, and inasmuch as no tax buyers are buying in the property at tax sale, they are simply holding off payment of taxes, where the pressure of a foreclosure suit, or even of the

organization of a group for the purpose of protecting the bondholders' interests, would undoubtedly materially aid in solving the difficulties in the present situation. It is the desire and intention of the committee to handle this as cheaply, as quickly and as efficiently as possible for the benefit of all depositing bondholders; the committee members, as stated before, are giving their service gratis. "In addition to Mr. Florsheim, the other members of the committee are as follows: B. W. Cooke of Glenview, chairman of the board of the Coyne Electrical School, Chicago; Howard Huber of Zimmer and Huber of Highland Park; Benjamin F. Lewis, former mayor of Highland Park; Miss Nellie Carlin of Ravinia, attorney of Chicago; Walter I. Schiff of Highland Park; of Eastman Dillon and Company Chicago; and H. F. van Steenderen of Highland Park, representing Curtis N. Kimball of W. W. Kimball Company. The legal counsel is Bowen E. Schumacher, of Highland Park and Chicago.
