Township Meeting to Be Held Here Again Next Tuesday Night

The annual town meeting in Deerfield Township, which was adjourned from Tuesday of last week, April 4, will be held on Tuesday evening of next week, April 18, at 8 o'clock at the Elm Place School auditorium.

This will be a public meeting and

all voters of Deerfield Township have the right to attend and to vote on the questions which will be brought up.

It was disclosed at the meeting on April 4 that the township closed its year with a deficit of approximately \$16,000, after spending \$60,000 during the last fiscal year. Heretofore, the township had never spent more than \$10,000, but last year the state law requiring the townships to take care of poor relief was put into effect, with the result that practically all townships in the state are in a financial muddle over having to budget much more than ordinarily required to take care of the ordinary business.
