**North Shore Motors Has Hudson, Essex Terraplane Agency**

The North Shore Motors, Inc., 108 North First Street, Highland Park, has recently secured the agency for Hudson and Essex Terraplane cars for the North Shore, to companion their Cadillac and LaSalle automobiles.

The Essex Terraplane is the fastest small car built, having to its credit 46 official A.A.A. records, which include a host of speed and mountain climbing records.

The Terraplane Six won the Spencer Penrose Trophy for the Pike's Peak climb, establishing a new all-time record; the second speed record over a mile course from a flying start at 62.521 miles per hour; and from a standing start over a mile course, shattered all records by establishing an average speed of 67.967 miles per hour. These records were established in stock cars; in most cases a sedan was used.

The Terraplane has an all-steel body, X-type frame and lower center of gravity. It also handles easily and is considered to be a fine riding car, having a 113-inch wheelbase.
