e, the undersigned Master Barbers of Highland Park, Deerfield and Highwood, Illinois, in harmony with the National Administration in Washington, D. C., hereby agree to the following code for the operation of our shops; Beginning on September 1st, 1933, working hours shall be from 9 o'clock a.m. to 7 o'clock p.m., Monday to Friday, inclusive.

Saturdays from 8 o'clock a.m. to 9 o'clock p.m. No barber or beautician shall work more than eight hours in any one day. Shops shall not open on Sundays. EXCERPT FROM N.R.A. CODE barber shall be employed or shall work more than 48 hours in any one week. The hours of operation of any barber or

beauty shop shall not be reduced below 52 hours in any one week unless such hours were less than 52 hours July 1st, 1933." Prices-Haircut 50c-Men, Women, Children. Shave 25c.
