FIRE DEPARTMENT INSPECTS BUILDINGS REGULARLY

The Scout fire chief, Francis O'Connor, like other Scout city officials, was interviewed Saturday morning by a Scout reporter.

The firemen, it was found out, inspect business buildings for fire hazards twice a year, once during April and May and once during September and October. These inspections are made three times or more when the firmen think there are fire hazards.


