The first year of an experiment in county-wide library service in Putnam County, Illinois, has demonstrated that books are more popular among readers of the county than they were among Chicagoans and New Yorkers a year ago, according to a report received today from Miss Anna May Price, superintendent of the Library Extension Division of the State Library and President of the Illinois Library Association.
