Mr. and Mrs. William Joyce (Jacqueline Buhl) have returned from Texas and are staying with the A. R. Joyces on Egandale Road.

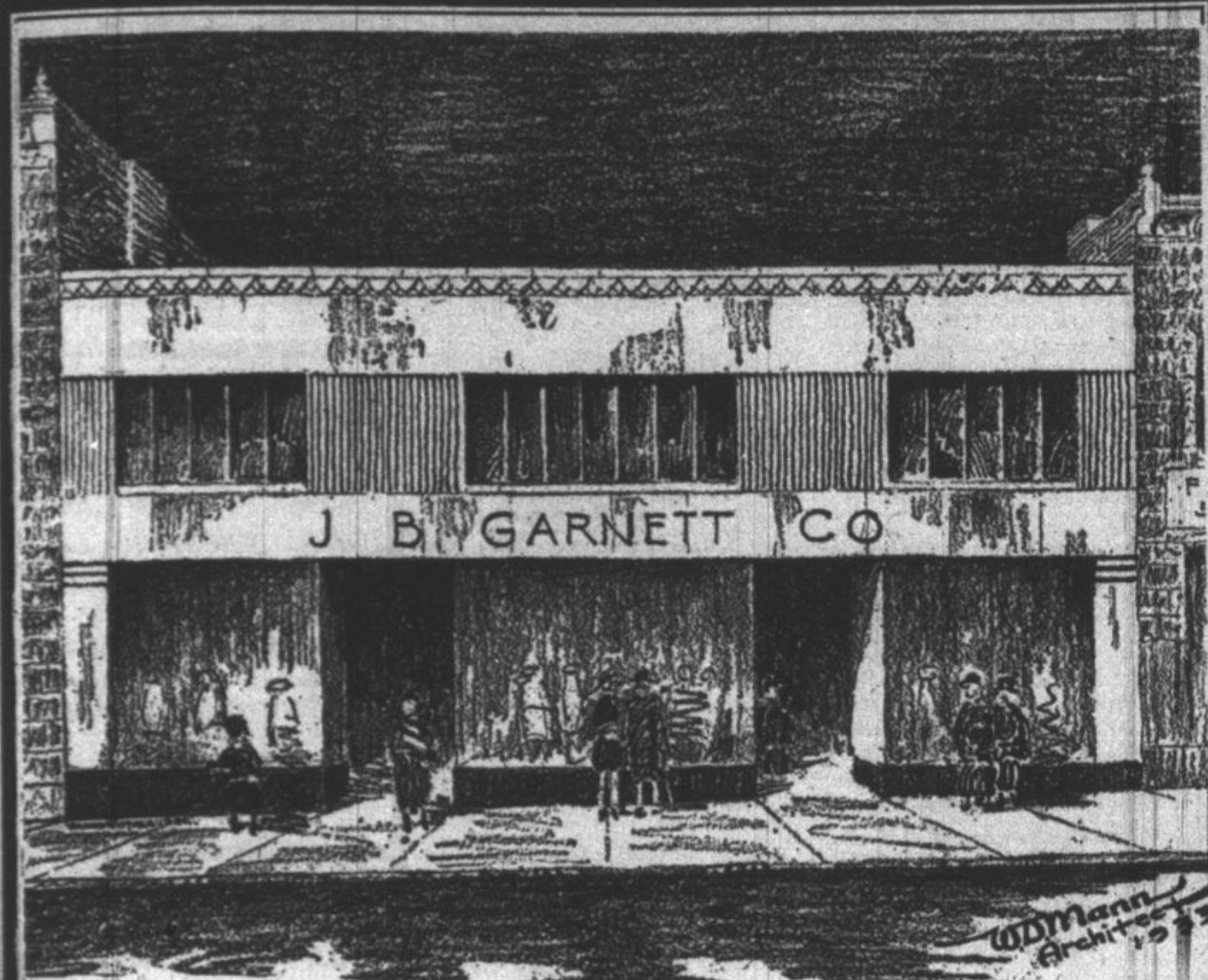
