

James Yore Drowns in Diamond Lake on Sunday

James Yore, 21-year-old son of Mr. and Mrs. George L. Yore, of South Telegraph Road, Lake Forest, drowned in Diamond Lake last Sunday morning about 11 o'clock. Mr. Yore and two companions were swimming in the middle of the lake, using a rowboat from which to dive, when the tragedy occurred.

The body was recovered about 5:30 Wednesday morning by an Indian diver of Portage, Wis., after other attempts had failed. Funeral services will be held at St. Patrick's Church, at Everett, at 10 o'clock this morning (Thursday) and burial will be in St. Patrick's Cemetery.

Mr. Yore was well known in Highland Park. He was a graduate of Deerfield-Shields High School. In addition to his parents, he is survived by the following brothers and sisters: Lawrence, Emmett, Frank, Nan and Regina.

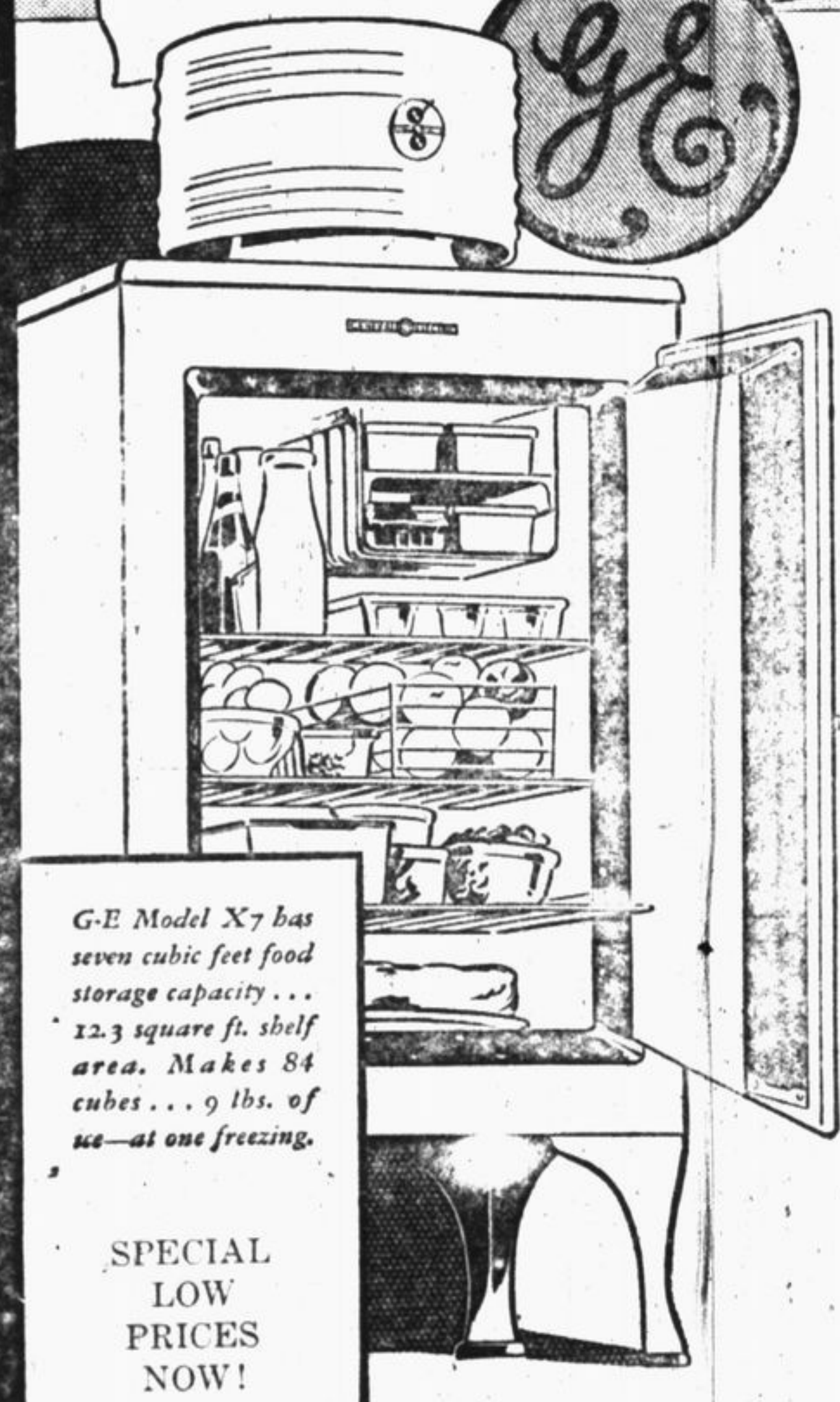
