

### Arden Shore Winter Camp to Open Nov. 1 for 40 Chicago Boys

The Arden Shore Winter Camp for Boys will open on Nov. 1. Thereafter, for five and one-half months, forty undernourished boys from Chicago will be given shelter, instruction and physical and spiritual building up, in one of the loveliest places along the North Shore—at the camp situated just north of Lake Bluff where their property runs from Sheridan Road to the shores of Lake Michigan.

In more prosperous years, the winter program was scheduled for seven months, but owing to decreased funds, the Arden Shore Board, of which Mrs. Kingman Douglass of Lake Forest, is president, has had to shorten the time in order that the boys may each receive the full share of good food, supervision and help to which he is entitled.

The Arden Shore Summer Camp for mothers and children ran at capacity this year, taking care of 1,365 people from Chicago's sweltering streets, providing them with a two weeks' outing in the country, excellent food and organized recreation.

Arden Shore is known as a "co-operating agency." It has no regular clientele of its own, but comes to the aid of other social agencies, sometimes with the regular allotment of places, sometimes with shelter for emergency cases. The social service departments of most of Chicago's large hospitals count on this, and are generous with their praises at the results. Six children sent out this summer from the Presbyterian Hospital to finish their convalescence, were highly approved at their return. A letter from Mrs. Theodore B. Sachs, executive director of the Chicago Tuberculosis Institute, to Miss Anna Belle Ferrier, head of the Arden Shore Camp, follows:

### 1935 Auto Licenses to Be Blue and Gray

Illinois automobile license plates for 1935 are being manufactured following award of contracts for 600 tons of steel and paint and enamel. The work is being done at the Stateville branch of the Illinois State Penitentiary.

The license plates next year will be pearl gray background with marine blue numerals. The contract for steel was let to three companies, the American Sheet and Tinplate Co., Chicago, the Granite City Steel Company and the Inland Steel Company, Chicago, and the 600 tons will cost approximately \$50,000. Paint and enamel will be furnished by the Towsey Paint and Varnish Company of Chicago, at an approximate cost of \$8,500.
