Announce Rates for New Sales Tax

In accordance with a ruling from Knowlton L. Ames, Jr., state collector of finance, merchants have put into effect a scale of rates permitting an equitable application of state retailers' occupation tax.

Under the schedule, all purchases to the value of 18 cents or less will be exempted from the tax; up to sales of from 19 to 65 cents, inclusive, 1 cent will be added; from 66 cents to \$1.24, 2 cents, and on all sales of \$1.25 or more, 2 per cent.
