ENTRANCE EXAMS FOR ANNAPOLIS IN APRIL... Congressman Church Announces Vacancy at United States Naval Academy

To fill a vacancy caused by the resignation of a midshipman, Congressman Ralph E. Church has been called upon to nominate a principal and three alternates by April 1 as candidates for admission to the Naval Academy, who will be examined by the Navy Department on April 17, 1935.

For any of his constituents seeking appointment Congressman Church has announced a special Civil Service examination to be held on Saturday, March 16.

Those wishing to compete in this examination for appointment should write Congressman Ralph E. Church, House of Representatives, Washington, D. C., by Monday, March 11, designating his choice of any one of the above listed places of examination.

Navy Department regulations provide that the candidates be no less than 16 years of age and no more than 20 years of age on April 1, 1935.

CALLING AN ORDINANCE... BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE HIGHLAND PARK EAST PARK DISTRICT, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1. That the general biennial election of the Highland Park East Park District be held on the first Tuesday in April, A. D. 1935, to-wit, April 2, 1935, between the hours of 6:00 o'clock in the morning and 5:00 o'clock in the afternoon of said day, for the purpose of electing the following officers of the said Highland Park East Park District, to-wit:

- Two Commissioners for the full term of six years. SECTION 2. That each of the election precincts of said Highland Park East Park District as described and created in and by an ordinance entitled, "An Ordinance creating and defining election precincts in the Highland Park East Park District," passed on the 19th day of February, 1935, and be and they are hereby respectively, declared and created election districts on or prior to the 15th day of February, 1935, and for each of the respective precincts shall be as follows:

SECTION 3. That the following named voters of said Highland Park East Park District be and they are hereby, respectively, appointed and created Judges and Clerks of an for said election:

Chambers, Catherine Yager, Vera Glander, Frank Moroney, Oscar Lindblom, Cora St. John, Beta Riley, Hazel Miller, Helen K. Coleman.

SECTION 4. That the Secretary of the Highland Park East Park District be and she is hereby directed to provide for the giving of notice of said election and conducting the same as provided by law and notify the Clerks and Judges of Election, on the morning and shall be closed at 5:00 o'clock in the evening of the first Tuesday of April, A. D. 1935.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE HIGHLAND PARK EAST PARK DISTRICT, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1. That the Highland Park East Park District and the territory embraced within its limits be and is hereby divided into five (5) election precincts and the same are hereby fixed as hereinafter provided, that is to-wit:

The First Precinct shall consist of all the territory and area embraced within the following boundaries, to-wit: All that portion of the Highland Park East Park District which lies East of the center line of the Easterly right of way of the Chicago & Northwestern Railway Company and West of the center line of Beech Street, in said Highland Park East Park District.

The Second Precinct shall consist of all the territory and area embraced within the following boundaries, to-wit: All that portion of Highland Park East Park District which lies South of the North line of Sections 24-35-36, Township 43 North, Range 12 East and South of the North line of Sections 21, Township 43 North, Range 13 East and North, Range 12 East, and of Section 20, Township 43 North, Range 13 East, lying Southeast of the center line of Beech Street and Northeast of the center line of the Easterly right of way of the Chicago & Northwestern Railway Company and including that portion of the subdivision known as the First Addition to the City of Highland Park, Lake County, Illinois, lying North of the North line of Section 26, Township 43 North, Range 12 East.

The Third Precinct shall consist of all the territory and area embraced within the following boundaries, to-wit: All that portion of the Highland Park East Park District lying East of the West line of Section 27, Township 43 North, Range 12 East, North of the North line of Sections 24-35-36, Township 43 North, Range 12 East, West of the center line of the Easterly right of way of the Chicago & Northwestern Railway Company, and South of the South line of Section 23 & 23, Township 43 North, Range 12 East, except that portion of the subdivision known as the First Addition to the City of Highland Park, Lake County, Illinois, lying North of the North line of Section 26, Township 43 North, Range 12 East.

The Fourth Precinct shall consist of all the territory and area embraced within the following boundaries, to-wit: That portion of Highland Park East Park District which lies West of the center line of the Easterly right of way of the Chicago & Northwestern Railway Company, East of the West line of Sections 27 & 26, Township 43 North, Range 12 East, North of the North line of Sections 27 & 26, Township 43 North, Range 12 East and including all that part of the Highland Park East Park District lying West of the West line of Section 27, Township 43 North, Range 12 East of the Third Precinct Meridian.

The Fifth Precinct shall consist of all the territory and area embraced within the following boundaries, to-wit: All that portion of the Highland Park East Park District which lies South of the North line of Section 23, Township 43 North, Range 12 East and West of the East line of Section 28, Township 43 North, Range 12 East, Township 43 North, Range 15 East. SECTION 2. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

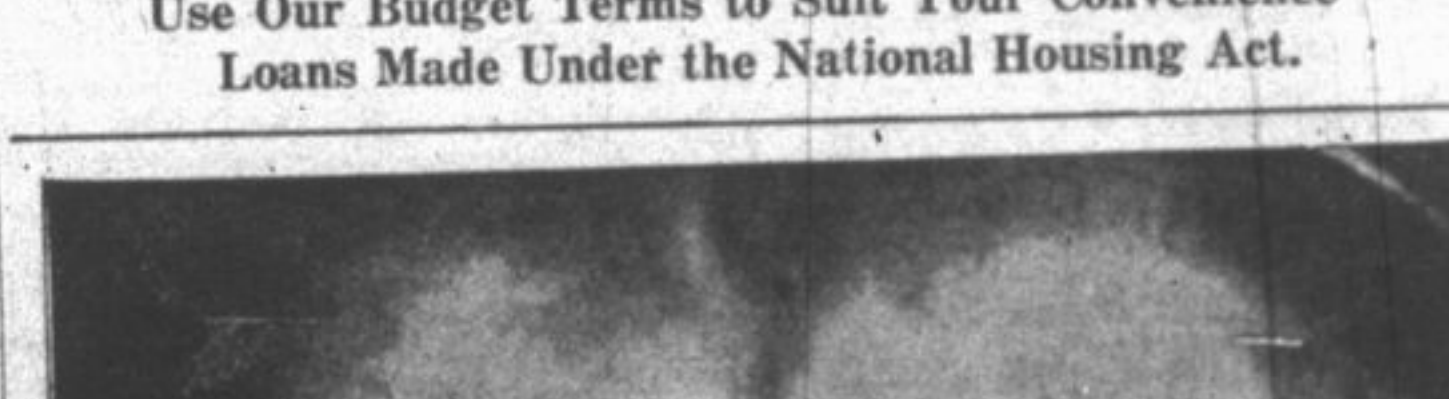
