Ill. Bell Announces New Rate Schedule

Beginning June 1, night rates for out-of-town telephone calls will go into effect at 7 p.m. instead of 8:30 p.m. as at present, according to an announcement made today (Friday) by the Illinois Bell Telephone Company which stated that the new

schedule had been duly submitted to the Federal Communications Commission and the Illinois Commerce Commission. The change applies to station-to-station calls for which the daytime charge is more than thirty-five cents and it entirely eliminates the higher evening rate period. The day period will be from 4:30 a.m. to 7 p.m. with night rates in effect during the balance of the time. This

change will be a convenience because it will not be necessary to wait until 8:30 p.m. for the lowest rates.

Also on June 1, night rates for telephone calls to Europe will be put into effect for the first time. From 5 p.m. to 5 a.m. the charge will be \$9 less than the daytime rate for a three-minute call to any European point. For example, the date rate for a call from Illinois to London,

England, will continue to be \$33. After 5 p.m. a three-minute call there will cost \$24. The hours of transatlantic night service are not the same as those for domestic night service because of the differences in time between the United States and Europe.

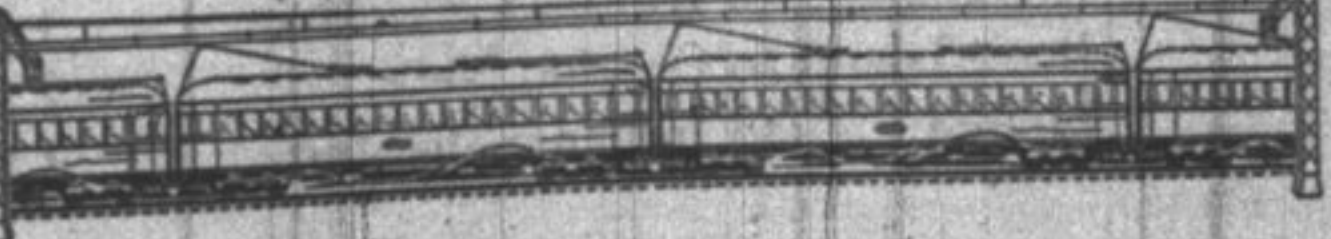
