

Cost of Administering NRA Above 93 Millions

New York—(IPS)—What cost NRA is revealed in a startling manner by a recent survey of the National Industrial Conference Board placing the expenses of administering the 878 codes during the two year period at \$93 million. This includes \$71,704,406 for code authority expenses, \$18,110,000 for the Recovery Administration, \$1,214,000 for the National Labor Board, and the other expenses.

In addition there are other millions, untabulated, of code authorities such as those of steel and the automobile industry, which assumed the burden of administration with their already existent facilities and did not file budgets with the NRA.

"Insect Comedy" Opens N. U. Theater Season

The "Insect Comedy" will open the dramatic summer season at the Northwestern University Theater on July 2 under the direction of John Baird. The authors, the two Check Brothers, Capek, have divided their satire into a prologue and an epilogue, and four acts, the first of which examines society, the second, economics under capitalism, the third the futility of war, and the fourth the brevity of life.

Critics say that two important contributions to the success of the

play are the lighting effects which intensify the abstract values, and the use of mass color. The stage sets suggest the effect of a flower heart, a dung heap and an ant hill and their insects as seen through the magnifying glass of a lepidopterist. So great was the hit of the play when presented in December that by popular demand it was repeated.

The Mid-West Institute of International Relations has taken over the theater for the opening evening. Information and tickets may be secured from the local committee of which Mrs. I. M. Greenberg is chairman.

"Ad" Men Urged to be Pilots for Recovery

Chicago—(IPS)—"Advertising has a splendid opportunity at this very moment to do a job for the United States in putting men and capital to work."

In these words, Chester H. Land, president of the Advertising Federation of America, called upon advertising men to pilot the way to recovery as he addressed the organization's annual meeting. He made brief reference to the Supreme Court's NRA recent decision, saying "Advertising needs no codes—progress is our code."

Statistics compiled by some of the leading authorities in America support the advertising chief's claim that increased advertising and recovery are marching hand in hand. Cities and regions in which advertising has made greatest gains in re-

cent months show a correspondingly climb in factory employment, and wholesale and retail trade.

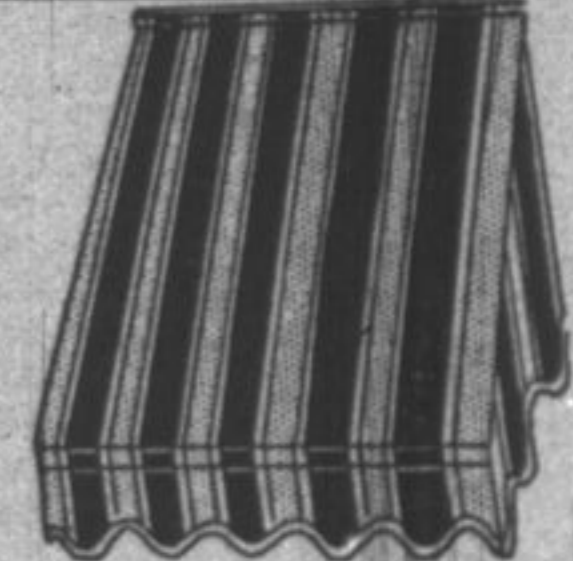

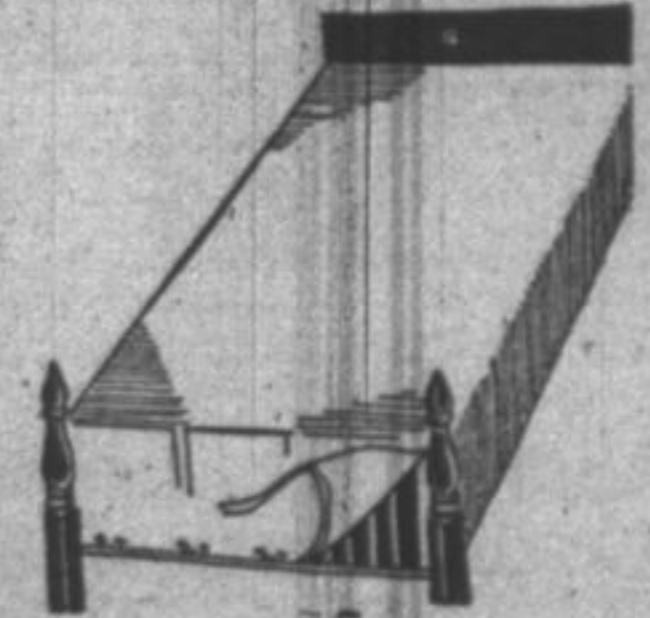
