

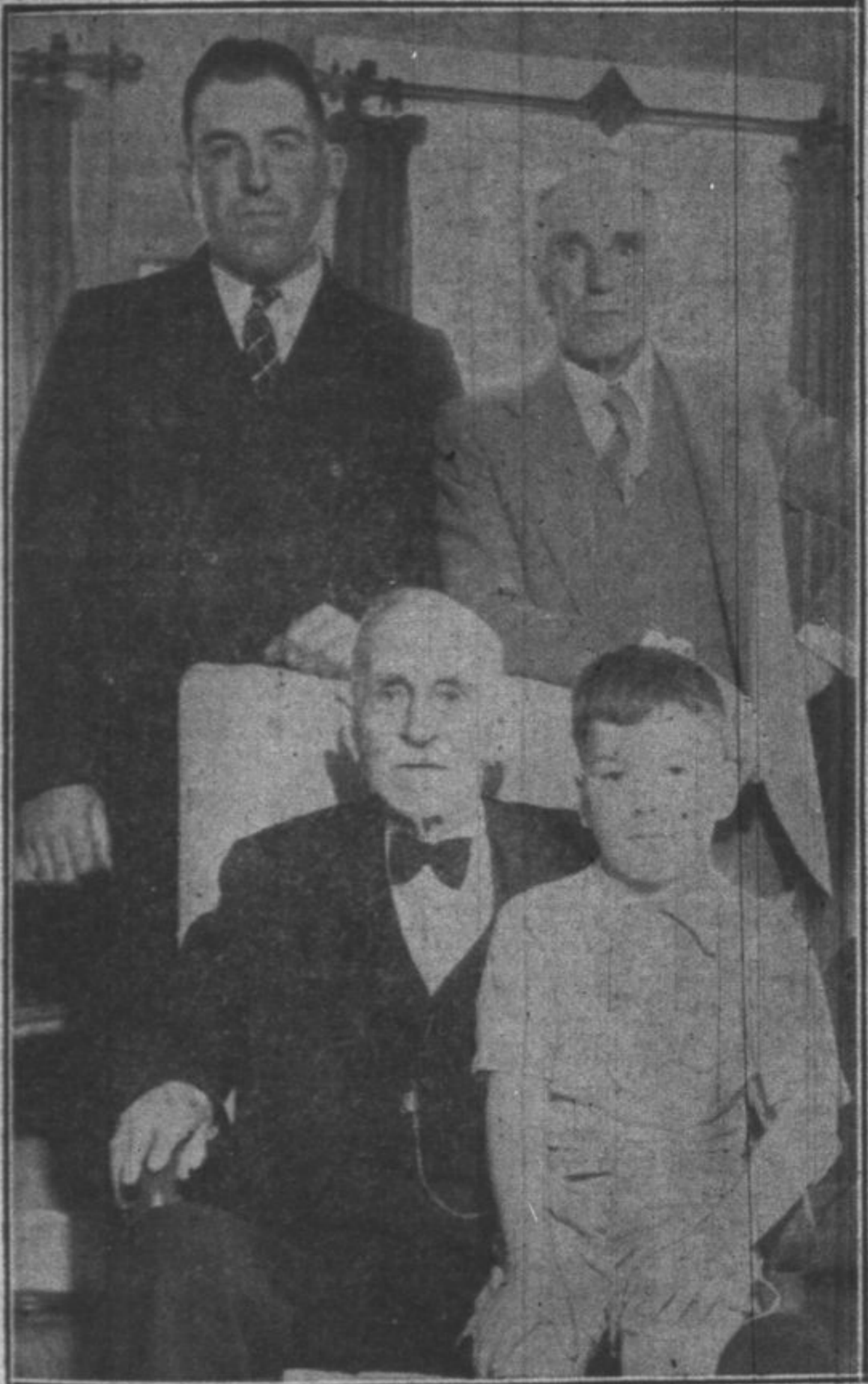
Deerfield Residents Examining Relic



A. H. Muhlke, 73-year-old Deerfield resident, is pictured here with his granddaughter, Betty Muhlke, age 13, examining some antique bellows which formerly were owned by John K. Clark, known as 'Indian' Clark, who lived in Deerfield and who conducted a poney express from Ft. Dearborn to Milwaukee. He came to Chicago in 1818. The bellows will be one of the many objects of interest at the Deerfield centennial which opens June 26.

Since Mr. Muhlke is a grandson of the pioneer Frederick Muhlke, who came to Deerfield in 1837, and has spent his entire 73 years in Deerfield, his interest in the centennial celebration is keen. His father was Charles G. Muhlke, who came to Deerfield as a young child with his parents from Saxton Hagen, Germany. Betty Muhlke is the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Harry Muhlke, also of Deerfield.

AN ORDINANCE MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR CORPORATE PURPOSES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR FROM MAY 1ST, 1935, TO APRIL 30TH, 1936.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIGHLAND PARK, COUNTY OF LAKE AND STATE OF ILLINOIS:

Section 1: That the following sums, or as much thereof, as may be authorized by law, be and the same are hereby appropriated for the corporate purposes for the fiscal year commencing May First, Nineteen Hundred Thirty-Five (1935) and ending April Thirtieth, Nineteen Hundred Thirty-Six (1936).

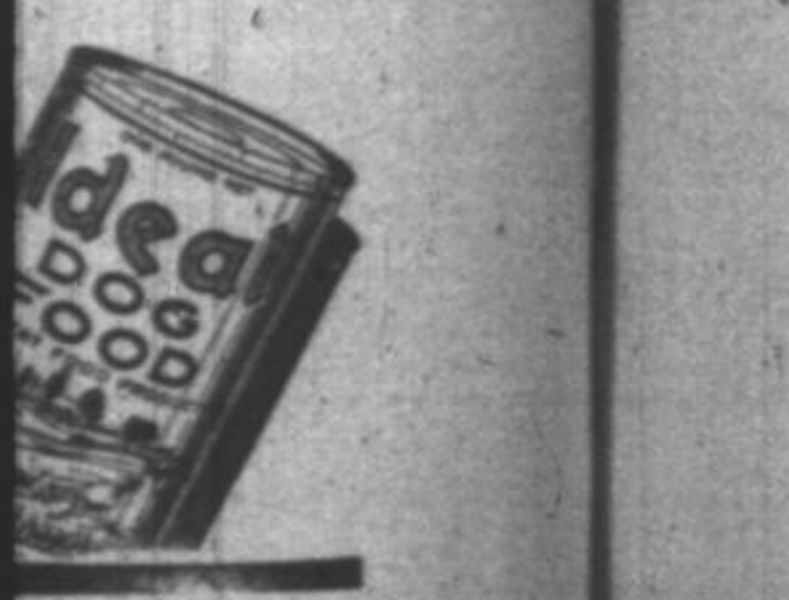
