AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE "AMENDMENT TO THE ZONING ORDINANCE" PASSED JANUARY 27, 1930

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIGHLAND PARK:

Section 1. That an ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE amending an Ordinance entitled 'An Ordinance to regulate and limit the height and bulk of buildings; to regulate and limit the intensity of the use of lot areas, and to regulate and determine the areas of open spaces within and surrounding such buildings; to classify, regulate, and restrict the location of trades and industries and the location of buildings designed for specified industrial, business, residential, and other uses; to divide the entire City of Highland Park into districts for the purpose of this ordinance; to fix standards to which buildings or structures shall conform; to prohibit uses, buildings, or structures incompatible with the character of such districts respectively; and to prevent additions to and alterations or remodeling of existing buildings or structures in such a way as to avoid the restrictions

and limitations lawfully imposed hereunder, and to provide penalties for violation hereof, as amended," be and the same is hereby amended as follows:

That Paragraph 19 under "B" District, Section 2, Article III, shall read as follows:

All of the following lots and blocks in Highland Park, a subdivision in Sections 23 and 24, and part of fractional Section 14, Township 43 North, Range 12 E. of the 3rd P.M. Lots 15 to 28 both inclusive, Block 4; lots 2 to 28, both inclusive, Block 5; lots 7 to 29, both inclusive, Block 6; lots 23 to 34, both inclusive, Block 7; lots 1, 2, 3, and 4, Block 8, except Mollie H. Apple's Sub; lots 5, (except the Northern 8 ft.) 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8 both inclusive, Block 9; Mollie H. Apple's Sub. of part of lot 1 of said Block 8, Highland Park; also lots 14 and 15 of said Block 9 (except the Southern 200 feet of said lots 14 and 15); lots 3 to 14, both inclusive, Block 10; all lots in Blocks 11 and 12; lots 8 to 18, both inclusive, Block 13; lots 1 to 4, both inclusive, Block 14, except the Southern 200 feet thereof; the Southern 180 feet of the Western 200 feet of Block C; Block D (except the southerly 225 feet thereof); M. Sheehan's Sub. of the Southern 225 feet of Block D, Highland Park; Evans Sub. of Block E, Highland Park; all the lots in Block F, Highland Park.

Also that Section 2, Article III "C" District shall be amended by adding thereto, the following:

Lots 1, 2 and the Northern 8 feet of Lot 3, Mollie H. Apple's Sub. of part of Lot 1, Block 8, Highland Park.

Section II. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with or inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section III. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect, from and after its passage, approval, recording and due publication.

Bail Bond Racket No Longer Flourishes

Chicago, Ill. July 2.—According to the State's Attorney's report on the bail bond racket which has just been released, bond forfeitures are no longer popular among prospective inhabitants of the penitentiary.

When a prisoner is released on bond, the normal procedure is for someone to furnish bail, usually in the form of real estate as security. It was not unusual prior to the term of State's Attorney Courtney to have an average of 25 bond forfeitures a month, with the consequent revelation that the security was either bogus or worthless. In 1926-27, before Mr. Courtney's term, there were 652 forfeitures; and in 1928-29, 605 forfeitures. During 1933 and 1934, Mr. Courtney's first two years in office, this

number of bond forfeitures was 125, or an average of 5 a month, and during the four months of 1935, the total was 13, or an average of 3 each month; a reduction of over 60 per cent in bond forfeitures.

This means that when the criminal is caught he is tried on his charge and is not permitted to escape by use of worthless bonds which permit him to secure his liberty and then fail to appear for his trial.

Likewise, these figures clearly indicate that the professional bond racketeers have been smashed and that bond rings are no longer a common thing in Cook County. Under Courtney an agency has been established to examine and pass on all real estate securities offered as bail, while collections on defaults have been faithfully enforced. This agency has taken the profit out of the firms organized to supply bogus bonds to criminals for exorbitant fees.
