An elaborate entertainment in modern and old master manner will be a feature of the evening and will include Corinne, the celebrated apple dancer, a free life class, and many other well known dancers and singers.

Tickets for the ball may be purchased at the Art Institute, at Marshall Fields and at the Drake hotel. Patrons for the ball include many of the trustees of the Art Institute and most of the better known Chicago artists.
