HIGHLAND PARK HOSPITAL CERTIFICATES Issued to Chest Subscribers

Twenty-five per cent (25%) of each Chest Subscription to be returned to subscribers in form of Hospital Certificates.

Each subscriber to the Highland Park Community Chest will be entitled to free service at the Highland Park Hospital (not including doctors' fees) for 25% subscription.

When full payment accompanies the subscription to the Community Chest or is received at one time, a service certificate will be issued to the subscriber by the Hospital for 25% of the amount of the subscription.

When partial payments are made in connection with subscriptions to the Community Chest, service certificates will be issued only in amounts of \$1.00 or more. Amounts less than that will be recorded on the Hospital's books to the credit of the subscriber, until the amounts so

credited equal \$1.00, at which time a service certificate will be issued.

Sample Hospital Certificates are included in each campaign worker's kit.

Highland Park Man Found Shot To Death

Thomas T. Roberts, 41 years old, 2472 Deer Park drive, was found shot to death in his car late Tuesday in a desolate section of Hiawatha woods, two and a half miles west of Deerfield. Chief of Police Percy McLaughlin of Deerfield said Roberts apparently had shot himself.

George Burack, 6315 N. Maplewood avenue, and his family came upon the body while they were gathering nuts in the woods. A revolver, from which one shot had been fired, was clutched in Roberts' right hand.

Mrs. Geraldine Roberts, wife of the broker, who was vice-president of the Lerand company, 11 South La Salle street, said her husband

had been worrying for some time. It was learned that Roberts was toying his home on a \$15,000 foreclosure. Judge Ralph J. Dady in the Lake county Circuit court at Waukegan yesterday appointed A. E. Smith of Waukegan as receiver for the property over the objections of Roberts' lawyer.

There are two children in the Roberts family, Thomas T. Jr., 11 years old, and Mary Patricia, 9 years old.
