N. S. Women Voters Hold Legislative Meeting

The North Shore Leagues of Women Voters, from Evanston to Waukegan, inclusive, will hold their annual legislative meeting at the Georgian Hotel, Evanston, Monday noon, Dec. 2.

All national and state legislators, representing the north shore, were invited to participate in the discussion of the league's measures recommended for support. Among those present were the Hon. Ralph E. Church, Assemblymen Barbour, Foster and Bauerback.

The chairmen of the league's six departments outlined briefly the points of greatest emphasis in their respective committees. Miss Irwin on behalf of the committee on government and international cooperation presented several phases of the neutrality problem. Mrs. Wheeler discussed the social and economic welfare bills to come up for consideration both in Springfield and in Washington. She also reviewed the league's position on education, namely, the larger school unit for administration and taxation as well as a large state school distributive fund so as to insure equal educational opportunity for all.

NEW PWA GRANT FOR HIGHLAND PARK

A PWA grant of \$106,363 to the North Shore Sanitary district for improvements and extension of sanitary sewer system, estimated to

cost \$236,363 and require 43 weeks to complete was announced last week.

The district serves that part of Lake county adjacent to Lake Michigan, from Highland Park to Winthrop Harbor. A new treatment plant will be built at Ravine drive, Highland Park, where a small septic tank is now in use. The new plant will have provisions for chlorinating and dewatering the sludge, and will be adequate for a population of 4,500. The project also includes the enlargement of the present Highwood treatment works, built in 1922 for a population of 2,000, to serve a population of 6,000, using the present methods of primary and secondary treatment. Approximately 1,000 feet of 15-inch connecting sewer will be built from the Waukegan sewer to the Sand street treatment plant.

Creating an estimated 112,752 man-hours of direct labor, with a labor cost of \$106,359, the project will employ a daily average of 116 men.
