...sic that outsiders could actually get the feel of the people and the significance of their lives. Through a grant of the Carnegie Corporation, Mrs. Boulton was able to take with her a highly sensitive sound equipment. These recordings together with the motion pictures and beautiful colored slides bring a complete presentation of Africa's unique and primitive culture.

Mrs. Boulton has appeared in Chicago before the Chicago Woman's club, whose comment on her program was, "The playing of the music on the different native instruments and the fascinating motion pictures give the listener an unusual experience. Laura delighted our most discriminating audience and was invited to appear before the club again this year." Among the many important clubs, colleges and other organizations before which Mrs. Boulton has appeared are the University of Chicago, Chicago Musical College, the Chicago

Geographical Society, the Friday Club, the Arts Club, the Renaissance Society, and in New York before the Julliard School and the American Museum of Natural History. Mr. Carleton Washburne, director of the Winnetka schools, says of Mrs. Boulton's work, "The material she has gathered from Africa is perfectly fascinating. I find it difficult to speak with restraint concerning the value and interest of the material Mrs. Boulton brings to an audience and concerning her delightful way of bringing it."

Mrs. Boulton has made four trips to Africa; with the Straus Central African Expedition for the American Museum of Natural History, New York; with the Carnegie South African Expedition, for Carnegie Museum; with the Pulitzer Angola Expedition, for Carnegie Museum; with the Straus African Expedition, for Field Museum of Natural History, Chicago.
