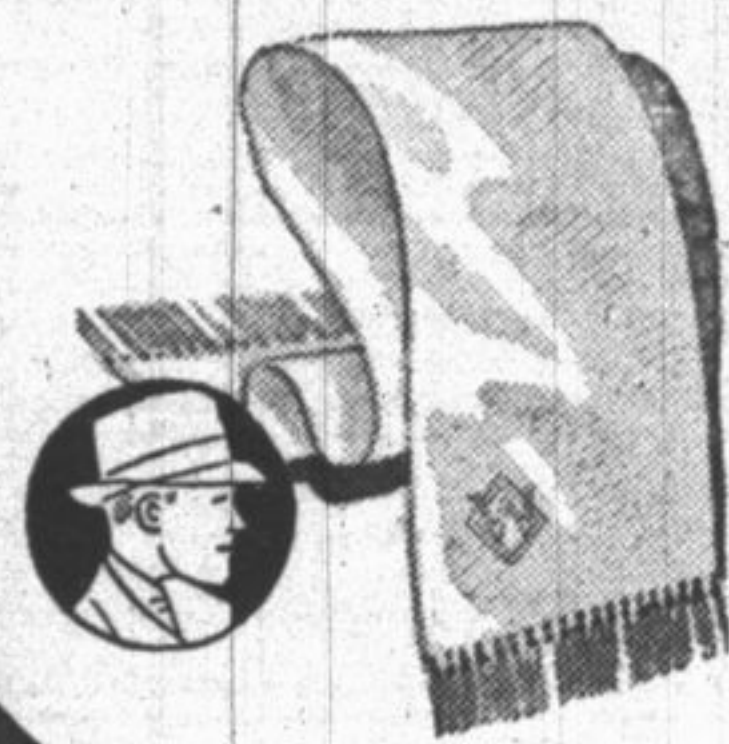
LOCAL GIRL HONORED

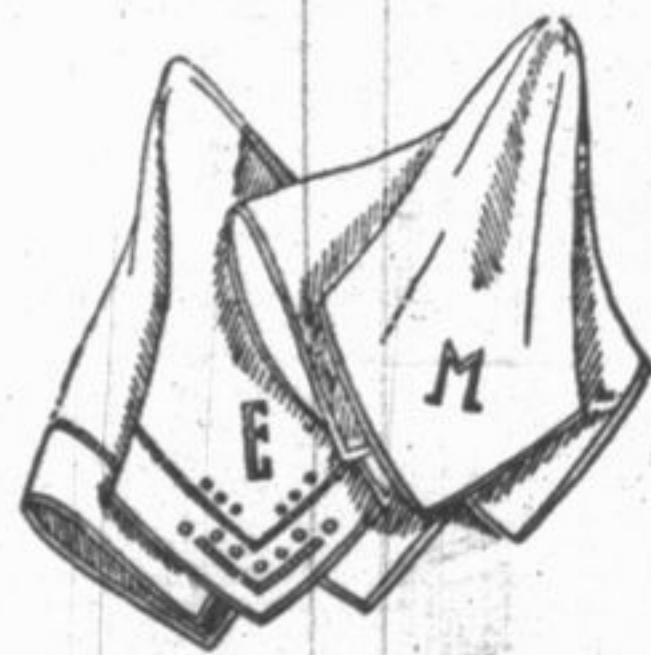
