Why not make that birthday party a combination with one of the above important events, carrying out in detail the decorations of the important one and a real "Happy Birthday" cake, for the one honored.

**Valentine Menu**  
Consume Valentine  
Heart Shaped Biscuits  
Celery Radishes  
Ham Steak, Valentine

**Consume Valentine**  
Heat beef consommé (left-over or canned) to boiling point and remove from fire. Add 1/4 cup sliced beets, cut in heart shape with small vegetable cutters or scissors. Serve at once.

**Ham Steak, Valentine**  
Place large slices of ham, (sliced 1/2 inch thick,) on broiler rack and broil until slightly brown on both sides. Place slices of pineapple on ham and return rack to broiler and brown pineapple to a delicate golden brown. Remove from broiler and place on hot platter. Place two or three small cinnamon hearts on pineapple slices before serving.

**Fruit Salad**  
Use equal parts of canned red cherries and white grapes, sprinkle with sugar, mixing well to dissolve the sugar, serve on lettuce leaves with mayonnaise to which whipped cream has been added. Sprinkle paprika, lightly over top of mound.

**Strawberry Trifle**  
1 tbs. Knox unflavored gelatin  
3 tbs. cold water  
1 cup fresh strawberries, crushed  
1/2 cup sugar  
1 teas. lemon juice  
1/4 teas. salt  
1 cup whipping cream (whipped).  
Soak gelatin in cold water for 5 minutes. Wash, hull and crush strawberries, add sugar. Add to it the lemon juice and salt. Combine the strawberries with gelatin and mix thoroughly. Whip cream and to it add the strawberry mixture. Pour into molds and chill thoroughly until set.

**Heart Shaped Individual Cakes**  
Make your favorite cake in a shallow pan — when cool use heart

shaped cookie cutters and cut out individual cakes. Ice with a dark pink icing or a white icing, placing a medium sized red cinnamon heart on top of each.

If a night party is to take place, instead of a dinner party — a Valentine Buffet supper will be a delight to all present.

**Valentine Buffet Supper**  
Celery Radishes  
Stuffed Olives  
Valentine Sandwiches  
Valentine Brick Ice Cream or Heart Shaped Cakes

A plate of appetizers may also be set on the buffet if desired. Pimento stuffed olives are preferable.

**Valentine Sandwiches**  
With a heart shaped cookie cutter cut slices of bread and spread with a mixture of cream cheese and current jelly. Cover with another piece of bread same size, then with a much smaller cutter cut out a heart-shaped piece from the upper slice.

Variation: Use plain cream cheese and lay a slice of pimento under the cut-out heart.

Use special brick ice cream from your dealers. Slice and serve.

## Full Month Remains of Winter Sports

A full month of winter sports activities remain at Eagle River in the North woods of Wisconsin where more people in the Chicago district than ever before are spending week-ends, skiing, skating, dog sledding, tobogganing and tramping in the snow.

Headlined on a month crammed with activity is the program arranged in that territory for Washington's birthday week-end when special tours of three days in length, leaving Chicago on Thursday night and returning Monday night, will be operated in addition to the Chicago & Northwestern's usual Friday night to Monday morning all-expense tour.

On that week-end, the Wisconsin state amateur hockey play-offs will be staged in addition to the regular program of winter sports. Reservations already made this year by the Chicago & North Western railway are evidence that the winter sports idea is "catching on" in the middle west. More than a 100 per cent increase in past and future reservations has been recorded for people going to Jack O'Lantern Lodge and Hiawatha Lodge at Eagle River and Long Lake Lodge at Phelps, Wis.

## Stamp Facts

The Lincoln Memorial stamp was issued in 1909 to commemorate the one hundredth anniversary of the birth of President Abraham Lincoln. The head of Lincoln is taken from the famous St. Gaudens plaster cast then in the Corcoran Art Gallery at Washington, and there are three varieties of the stamp, 2) perforated 12 and watermarked double lined USPS and the other imperforate.

The 2c-Lincoln-perforated and on ordinary paper, was first put on sale at Washington, D.C. on January 28, 1909. It appears in Carmine and bright carmine, with very scarce slitch wmk, and a double transfer adjoining the side plate number on the upper left pane of plate 4918. 148,387,191 of the stamps were

printed from plates 4976, 4977, 4978, 4979, 4981, 4982, 4983, 4984.

The imperforate stamp was issued on February 4, 1909, for the use of the makers of vending and stamp affixing machines (in full sheets of 400 subjects) so that it is found with the Mail-O-Meter, Schermack, Brinkerhoff and U. S. Vending Machine company private perforations. 1,262,400 were issued, using all the same plates as for the perforated stamp, so the same double transfer is to be found on plate 4981.

The Post Office department was doing some paper experimenting at this time, testing a 30% rag stock in hopes that it would show less shrinkage. This paper has quite a bluish color, most noticeable from the back, and on February 4th the stamp also appeared on this paper, perforated. But 637,000 were issued, using only plates 4976, 4977, 4978 and 4979.

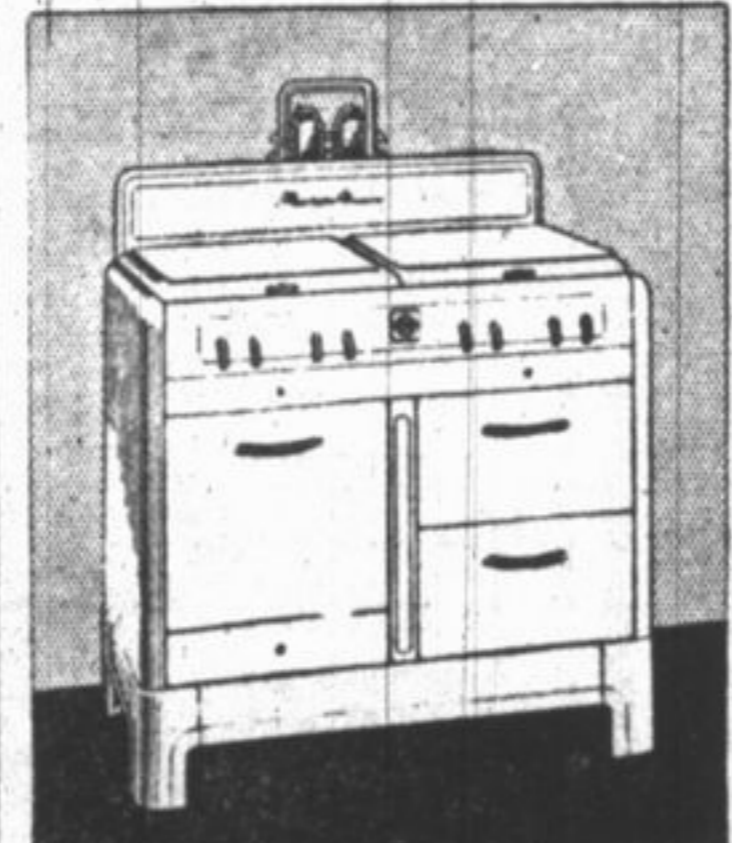

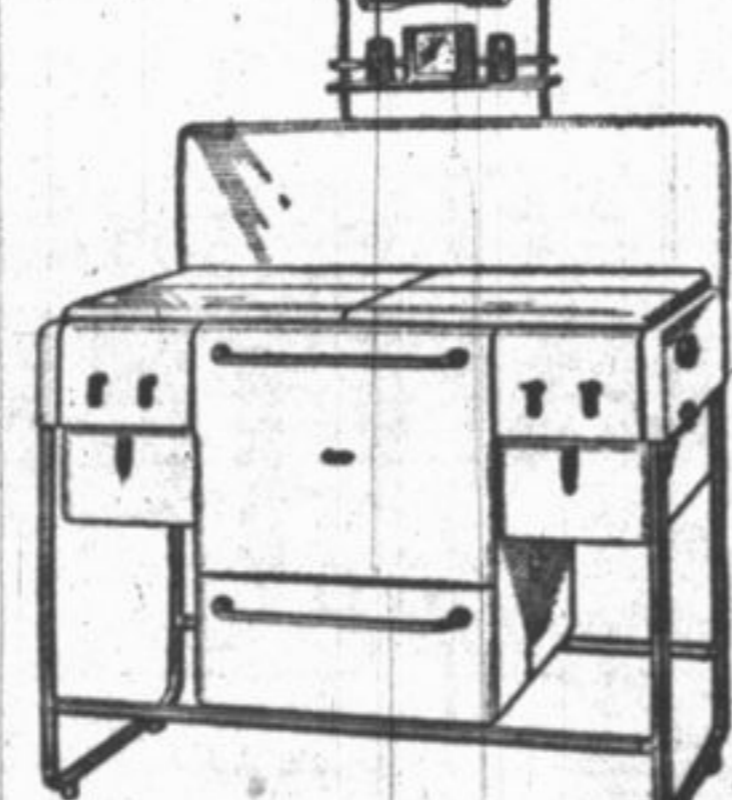

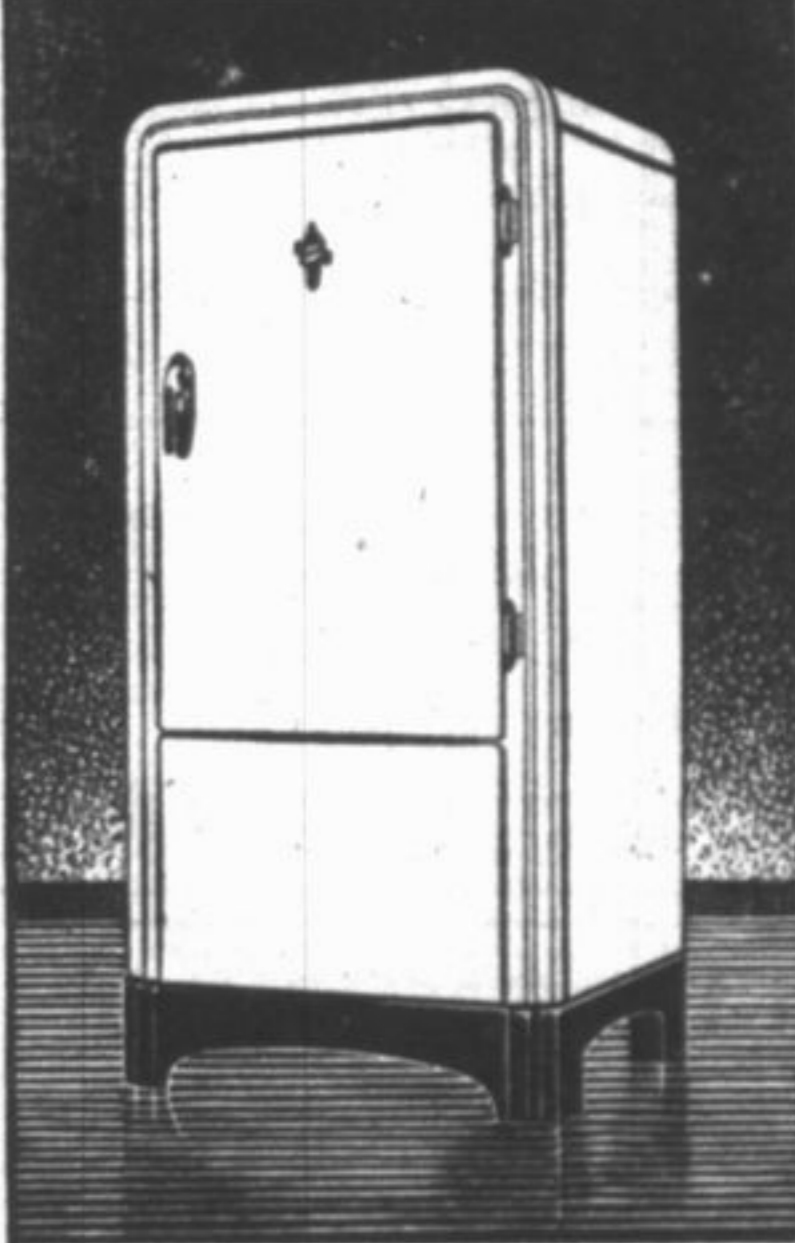
