**Strong Waterfront Staff Completed**  
A waterfront staff equal to any that Ma-Ka-Ja-Wan has ever had is all lined up and ready to make bigger and better history for swimming instruction and safe swimming at camp in 1936. As last year Dick Wichman will be in charge. He will have as his assistants, Jim Lytle, who was with the waterfront staff last summer, and Don Teoppen, who was Scoutcraft instructor last year. These three young men are all expert swimmers and instructors, all qualified by the Red Cross to teach water work and safety. Mr. Wichman is a qualified examiner for the Red Cross and because of this fact Scouts can complete their work for Junior and Senior Red Cross Life Saving and be given full credit. This staff will be enlarged during swim periods by the use of many more staff members and older campers as life guards and instructors in various fields of water craft and sport. Last year 100 per cent of the Scouts who went to Ma-Ka-Ja-Wan not able to swim were taught the elements of swimming and were able to swim at least 50 ft. before they went home. That number of non-swimmers was 63. Many more were taught to swim better and others learned life saving, canoeing, rowing, and Scout Life guard work.

1 cup butter  
2 cups granulated sugar  
4 egg yolks, beaten well  
4 egg whites, beaten stiff  
1 cup sweet milk  
3/4 cups cake flour  
2 teaspoons baking powder  
Juice of one orange  
Rind of two oranges  
Cream the butter and sugar thoroughly, and add egg yolks which have been well beaten. Sift powder and sift three times again. Add liquids and flour mixture alternately, beginning and ending with flour. Beat egg whites stiff and fold into mixture. Pour into oiled tins and bake 25 minutes in a moderate oven.

**Public Service Company Model Farm To Be Open for Inspection May 30**

The model farm of the Public Service Company of Northern Illinois, providing a place where people may see demonstrations of the latest electric equipment and lighting for farms and country homes, will be opened May 30, according to E. A. Menke, district superintendent of the company.

"Much of the hard work and many of the tiresome chores of farm life can now be done electrically, giving people who live in the country all the advantages and conveniences of city living," said Mr. Menke. "Recognizing the need for a practical source of information on how to use electricity on the farm to the best advantage, we are opening model farm to meet that need."

"Model farm is located on 152 acres of land about two miles north of Diamond Lake on route 50A. It will be managed by a practical farmer who will demonstrate the latest electric devices, products of modern inventive genius that are beginning to change farm life throughout the nation."

"Visitors may see what happened to the farm kitchen, how it has been transformed into a cool, convenient work-saving room. They may see electrified dairy buildings, a new method of controlled electric ventilation for barns, the exhibition hall where the latest electric farm appliances are shown and many new and interesting applications of electricity to 1936 rural living."

"The farm is open on week days from noon to 5:30 P.M. and all day on Saturdays and Sundays. In addition to the farm, there is a recreation field including a picnic grove, baseball diamonds, tennis courts, dance pavilion, refreshment stand, fully equipped shower and wash rooms and convenient parking space. These facilities are available to groups for outings and picnicking."
