July 3rd Conductor, ERNEST ANSERMET 1. Overture to Die Meistersinger Richard Wagner.

The Overture to Die Meistersinger is both a work of art and the answer of the musician Richard Wagner to his critics that he could not write counterpoint. The opera as a whole was completed Oct. 20, 1867, though the ideas for the whole gigantic comedy were in the mind of the composer long before that. So popular has this overture become that it almost invariably occupies the enviable position of opening or finishing a program. Throughout the whole of it there is foreshadowed the action of the drama to follow, the genial and sunny wisdom of Nuremburgh's cobbler poet Hans Sachs, the crabbed and selfish interference of the critic Beckmesser, and the idyllic love of Walther and Eva. Adding to this the pompous display of the Guilds and the child-like caperings of the Apprentices, and you have a picture of life in the old city of Nuremburgh almost five hundred years ago.
