Cakes... practically everyone is fond of this particular food. While men prefer devil's food, the ladies prefer angel food and sunshine and the children just cake.

White Cake
1/2 cup butter
1 cup sugar
2 teas. almond extract or vanilla extract, or half of each may be used.

Banana Cake
Cream thoroughly 1/2 cup shortening and 1 1/2 cups sugar. Add 3 egg yolks, well beaten and 1 cup banana pulp.

Date Delights
1/2 cup shortening
1 cup brown sugar
1 1/2 cups flour
2 1/2 tsp. baking powder
1 egg
1/4 teas. salt.

Wellesley Fudge Cake
1/2 cup shortening
1 1/2 cups sugar
2 eggs
2 cups flour
1/2 cup cocoa
1 teas. soda
1 teas. baking powder
1/2 teas. salt
1 cup sour milk
1/2 cup hot water

Emergency Cake
1 1/2 cups flour
1 cup sugar
1/2 cup salt
1 egg
2 1/2 teas. baking powder
1/2 cup shortening
1/2 cup milk (not too cold)
1 teas. flavoring

Household Hints

When baking or broiling fish, grease the pan with bacon fat in generous, lavish fashion. It gives the fish a fine flavor and also restores fats that are lacking in fish.

Try to use imagination in planning menus. Vary the foods and serve something different.

Large ripe and sweet watermelons, honeydew melons, gooseberries, blueberries, raspberries, and strawberries are all on the market.

Leftover boiled frankfurters or weiners make good stuffing for green peppers. Combine with fluffy boiled rice and seasonings and bake for luncheon.

Let potatoes that are to be French fried stand in cold water at least half an hour before frying. It makes them crisp.

As the contents of certain packages such as dog biscuits, soap powders, cereals, bird gravel and seed, etc., become diminished fear the cardboard down to lower levels.

One package of brown sugar, four eggs, one and three quarters cups of flour, one teaspoon baking powder, one teaspoon cinnamon, one half teaspoon cloves, one cup seedless raisins, one cup almonds chopped.

Beat eggs well, add sugar and other dry ingredients, raisins and nuts. The almonds need not be blanched. Spread evenly in three sheet pans and bake in moderate oven until done.
