Banana Cake

Cream thoroughly 1/2 cup shortening and 11/2 cup sugar. Add 3 egg yolks, well beaten and 1 cup banana pulp. (Sift flour before measuring). Into a sifter put 21/2 cups flour, 1 teas, salt, 3 teas, baking powder and 1/2 teas. soda. Add dry ingredients alternately with 1/2 cup soured cream. Lastly fold in 3 egg whites which have been stiffly beaten. Bake in two layer cake pans, well greased and floured in a 375 degree F, oven about 30 minutes. Ice with a banana

Sift flour once before measuring. Sift flour, sugar, salt and baking powder together. Measure softened shortening into cup and fill cup with milk. Add these, with the unbeaten egg to the flour mixture. Add flavoring, beat well for 2 or 3 minutes. Pour into greased and floured layer pans. Bake in moderate oven (375 degrees F) for 25 min.
