Albert Spalding Will Appear in Winnetka Music Club Series
Literally born with a silver spoon in his mouth, Albert Spalding, American aristocrat of the violin, who this fall plays in the Winnetka Musical Club Artist Recital Series as New Trier High School, has since the early days gone his own way.
Born in Chicago, young Albert studied in Florence, New York, and the Paris Conservatory. At twenty, he made his debut in Paris with Adelina Patti.

During the war, he enlisted as a private, soon became an officer in the aviation corps. In recognition for war services, he has been decorated with the Crown of Italy by the Italian government, and with the Cross of the Chevalier of the Legion of Honor by France.
As a young artist in search of concerts and recitals, Spalding went barnstorming through Europe, playing one night stands in towns and hamlets other musicians would pass by. Because of these trips, Spalding has been one of the favorites of Russia and the Balkans.
