Household Hints

Crispies, delicious with soup or coffee, may be made from bread dough. After the second rising of the dough roll a portion of it as thin as paper, brush over with melted butter, sprinkle with caraway seeds and cut into finger shapes. Bake at once in a hot oven.

Did you ever try chopping left-over fish and using it in hash instead of meat? To clean a griddle that has become crusted, put over a very hot fire and cover thickly with salt. After the salt has turned brown the crust and salt will brush off together, leaving the griddle like new.

To tell when a plant needs water take a pinch of dirt from the top of flower pot. If the earth is moist the plant does not need water. If dry and crumbly, water thoroughly. A delicious, sweet sandwich filling is made by combining graded pineapple and candied or preserved ginger that has been chopped fine.

A "garden of flavors" will prove interesting and useful to you. Most of the sweet herbs can be grown the first year from seed and some of them have a delightful fragrance. To prevent cornmeal mush from lumping during the cooking, mix the uncooked meal with cold water, using one-third as much water as meal and then add the boiling water and cook in a double boiler.

Cucumbers should be put in the refrigerator for last minute slicing after being peeled and scratched down the sides with a fork to give the scalloped effect that adds so much to their attractive appearance.

The dandelion was named in France, "dents de lion" (teeth of lion). It is so called because of its notched leaves, that resemble lions' teeth. It grows all over this country and in nearly all parts of the world.
