Registration Question A question regarding registration seems to be apparent in the minds of some people. It is not absolutely necessary that you register, for your vote may be sworn in, but to save time and trouble on election day, it would be well for every voter to see that his name is on the poll books. Therefore the law sets aside two days for registration, Oct. 13 and Oct. 27, at your respective polling places. If you have voted before and live at the same address, you need not bother to inquire, as your name will be registered; however, if you have moved, call up your precinct committeeman who will give you the necessary information where to register. Positive lists and addresses of your polling places will be published in a later issue of this paper.

Qualifications of a Voter He or she must be 21 years or

over, and lived in this state one year, in the county 90 days and in the precinct 30 days.

Absentee Voters Voters who are not now registered and wish to vote an absentee ballot must be registered in their respective precinct or their ballot will be refused. Make application by letter or person to the County Clerk's office, Waukegan, Ill., for an absentee ballot and when received and properly filled out, return same by mail to said County Clerk in plenty of time before election day.

Floyd and Louer Begin 2nd Coaching Year at Local H. S. Dave Floyd and "Chuck" Lauer are beginning their second season as head football coaches at Highland Park high school. This season was initiated with a double

triumph over Crystal Lake, Saturday. Floyd's varsity team defeated a large Crystal Lake outfit by an 18-0 victory, while Lauer's Frosh-Soph pulled a surprise scoring punch in winning 12-0.

Coach Floyd graduated from North Carolina State in 1929. At State he was a star tackle and end on an excellent team. Since coming to Deerfield in the fall of '29 he has acted as line or Frosh-Soph coach. Last year was his first as head varsity coach, and though the season was not especially a victorious one, the unexpected 6-0 win over the strong Morton team gave Floyd hopes for a better team this year.

"Chuck" Lauer, a graduate at New Trier in '26 and of Iowa U. in 1932, was a letter winner in both football and basketball. A star athlete both in prep and collegiate circles, Lauer has proved himself to merit the confidence placed in him when he was made head Frosh-Soph coach last year. His team won over

Crystal Lake, McHenry, and Morton by large scores last year. Then injury robbed his squad of Pete Wolfe, this year's varsity star center, and his team was forced out of the win column.

Floyd and Lauer are assisted this year by "Danny" Davitt and "Deke" Walters. These four men are working with a lot of promising material, especially in the varsity squad, and if they get any breaks at all should come through with a creditable if not a victorious season for the newly named Highland Park high school.

The games with Libertyville here Saturday and with Oak Park here a week later will prove real hurdles for both squads. Libertyville trounced the varsity last year 19-0 and will undoubtedly have another strong team in the field.
