The popular San Carlo Opera Company returns Oct. 5 to the Auditorium Theatre, Chicago, for an engagement of three weeks.

All the popular principals of last season have been re-engaged, and three outstanding new singers have been added. One is Stella Lenci, young Italian mezzo soprano.

Signorina Lenci, although Italian born, was reared in Minnesota. She completed her musical training with two scholarships at St. Cecilia's Conservatory in Rome, and made her operatic debut as Amneris in Aida at the Adriano Theater three years ago.

Miss Symons sang three years with the Philadelphia Grand Opera company and has been heard widely in recital.

Mr. Sakos was trained in Greece and in Italy. Carol Peroni, who is famous for being able to conduct sixty grand operas without consulting the score, has been re-engaged as general musical director of the company.
