The Voice of Cookery

conducted by PHIL LIBBY former Restaurateur - now Food Consultant Listen to THE VOICE OF COOKERY, featuring Phil Libby, over Station WCFL (970 kilocycles) every week day morning, except Saturday, at 10:30 a. m., for interesting food facts, recipes, household hints and cookery advice.

For those of my readers who are going to have a Hallowe'en party and have not decided on any particular menu, this issue offers you one for your approval.

Hallowe'en Menu Clear beef broth in cups Golden croutons Olives Radishes Tongue in sweet pickle jelly Baked whipped potatoes Hot buttered rolls Pumpkin pie (faced) Whether or not you serve home-made soup or canned, depends on the time you want to devote to the party. I might suggest as a time saver that you serve a canned beef broth if the party meal be a late one.

For the tongue in sweet pickle jelly... simmer a fresh tongue in salted boiling water until tender (about 2 hours). Remove skin and roots and trim into a neat shape. Take a quart of jelly... using 2 packages of orange flavored gelatin, 2 cups hot sirup from sweet pickles, and 2 cups cold water.

In a mold suited to the size of the tongue pour nearly half of the jelly, decorate the bottom of mold with olive slices and crystallized orange peel. When set, put in the tongue and pour over it the rest of the jelly. When set a little, decorate sides with olive slices and orange peel. Chill overnight. Unmold on platter and garnish with parsley and sweet pickles.

The baked whipped potatoes are simple. Make the usual mashed potatoes and put them in well buttered baking dish to bake a rich golden color. Serve with a part of the crust on each helping.

Household Hints

Foods that spoil readily, such as milk, soup stock and meats, should always be kept in the coldest part of the refrigerator.

Flaked salmon and chopped cucumber pickles moistened with mayonnaise make a tasty sandwich filling.

Speaking of making two eggs go a long way; do you know that you can double the bulk of scrambled eggs by adding corn flakes or crisp rice cereals to the egg mixture before cooking. Eggs mix well with cereals and the flavor is delicious.

If you save bacon fat and other drippings for frying, try pouring

The hot buttered rolls may be cloverleaf, Parkerhouse, or just plain rolls. But when serving after baking keep them hot by wrapping in tea towels.

When I said pumpkin pie (faced) I mean just that. Make your pumpkin pies in the usual manner... Shortly before you are to serve them, pipe eyes, nose, mouth and eyebrows on top with cream cheese or whipped cream, put through a pastry tube.

Cut chilled orange flavored gelatin cut in cubes, piled in sherbet glasses on top of peeled orange sections, then pour chilled soft custard over all. A delightful dessert for a children's party. Rosy red apple cups make attractive containers for fruit salads, desserts or appetizers. Fill with diced oranges, pineapple and cut seedless raisins, sweetened to taste. Add a dash of cider. Serve very cold.

For light Hallowe'en refreshments serve French Ginger Punch. Beat 1 cup lemon juice, 1 cup orange juice and 2 1/2 cups sugar until the sugar is dissolved. Strain thru coarse sieve, chill and then add 3 pints dry ginger ale. Turn into freezer or tray of automatic refrigerator and freeze to a mush. Serve in tall glasses with a sprig of mint dusted with confectioners sugar thrust in the top of each.

Another frozen beverage... Boil 1 cup each sugar and water 10 minutes. Cool, add 4 cups sweet cider, 1 No. 2 can pineapple juice, juice of 2 lemons. Freeze in refrigerator tray to a mush before serving in sherbet glasses.

Some Appetizer Hints/ Tomato culled with grapefruit and orange sections, garnished with capers and Parmesan cheese is a good beginner...
