

Centrella Bowling League Resumes Schedule January 7

Gebhardt's Chili Con Carne team continues winning streak by taking all three games from the Peacock "400 Club" team and now leads the league by a comfortable margin of four games.

Second place in the league is hotly contested with Stewarts Coffee, Chief Milani, Old Monk and Linco Products each winning 18 while dropping 12 games. Manor House Coffee trails the Big Four by a single game and the Town Crier Flour boys follow Manor House three games to the rear. Peacock "400 Club" team rests in eighth place, two games behind Town Crier and two games ahead of the Scot Towels, while the cellar position is assigned to Wilson's Ideal Dog Food team.

Last Thursday Scot Towels upset Old Monk upon receiving their new bowling shirts from S. P. Gerdl, the manager of the team, then went out after the league pace setters and captured two out of the three games from Old Monk, upsetting the dope that Old Monk would lead the league at the end of the first round. Stewarts Coffee made things mighty hot for Manor House and the results of the evening credit Stewarts with three games won. Chief Milani is another contender to bear watching and their fine team work brought three games into their winning column at the expense of the Town Crier boys. Ed Rugen and his Linco squad experienced little dif-

ficulty in chasing the Wilson Ideal boys further into the cellar position. C. Foss Winter, team captain of the Wilson Ideals, will confer with Wilson & Co.'s star sales representative, Mr. Roy Horres, during the holidays and it is rumored that Mr. Horres may enter the line-up as a member of the team. Other changes will follow, Mr. Winter said, "unless our team improves."

Two Hundred Club Going Strong
League chairman, Frank Waber, captain of the fast stepping Gebhardt's Chili Con Carne's, led the list of applicants into the now famous "Two Hundred Club" with a score of 212. Walter Scott of the Ringers, also listed officially as Chief Milani, was the second applicant rolling a neat 204.
