

### NOTES ON PHILATELY

The use of the catalog is essential to the collectors of postal paper. From the catalog we learn various information such as color, dates of issuance, watermarks, in which denominations issued, and the like.

The proper interpretation is necessary as each and every detail tends to make a stamp more or less desirable in the collection. The illustrations of the stamps give much help in finding the listings and to the topical collection the titles under the stamps furnish very valuable leads. The topical collector is one who collects stamps depicting such things as birds, maps, ships, religious subjects, etc.

To begin with, a stamp's listed value is supposed to be for items in good condition. This means fair in centering, undamaged, and if used, a good cancel (not smeared and defacing the stamp), and if unused, with full gum on the back.

Some countries had poor facilities for printing and separating stamps. One country even went so far as having the postman bite a corner off the stamp to show it was cancelled. Thus a complete used item from this country on certain items would be scarce. Many countries were afraid of the second use of the stamps so took extra precaution to see that they were well smeared. Thus on some items, an average copy is in a bad condition and a fair item above average.

The first number given an item in the catalog is what is known as its catalog number. The second number with a letter before it is the design number. There can be many stamps of the same design number but only those with the same catalog number are identical items. After the design or illustration number comes the denomination which is followed by the

color after which are the prices un-stamped and used.

If the stamp is listed as a surcharged or overprinted variety then after the color, in ( ) will be the abbreviation for the overprinted color, unless it is black, which is taken for granted.

A reprint and re-issue differ greatly in that the reprint is usually for philatelic purposes and person gain while the other is an item printed the second time for postal use with major or minor differences from the first issue such as a change of color or a re-engraving of the plates used.

In trying to classify a stamp, the first thing to look for is the design. Then note its number and follow down from there until the denomination and color coincide with the stamp being classified. This may be the same as the stamp, yet not correct as the stamp may have been re-issued with a different perforation, watermark or color, so following columns should then be noted for other listings on the same item. Should this happen you would then determine which one it was by deduction.

To learn the proper use of the catalog is to know your hobby better and nothing is thoroughly appreciated that is not well understood. The North Suburban Philatelic society at a meeting January 4, voted to hold an auction in conjunction with their annual dinner to be held on February 8 at the Green Tea Pot.
