It is evident that homemakers are starting the year right... the many requests I have received for recipes show me that. Both my air listeners and my readers have written requesting one or another recipe, so today I'll give you a few of them.

REFRIGERATOR CAKE

- 1 tablespoon plain gelatin
- 2 tablespoons cold water
- 1 cup milk
- 4 egg yolks
- 1 cup shredded cocoanut.
- 1 cup sugar
- 1 cup crushed pineapple, drained
- 1/2 cup drained red cherries
- 1 doz. lady fingers.

Soak gelatin in the cold water for 5 minutes. Prepare custard by combining egg yolks, slightly beaten, sugar and milk. Dissolve gelatin in hot custard. Cool. Fold in fruit and cocoanut. Line mold with lady fingers and pour in fruit mixture. Place in refrigerator for serving. Garnish with whipped cream. Serves 8 to 10.

GLAZED DIXIE LOAF

- 1/2 lb. chopped beef
- 1/2 lb. chopped veal
- 1/2 lb. smoked ham, chopped
- 1 tablespoon chopped onions
- 1 tablespoon chopped parsley
- 1 tablespoon chopped celery
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 teaspoon pepper
- 1/2 cup soft bread crumbs
- 2 tablespoons catsup
- 1/4 cup milk
- 1 egg, beaten.

Mix ingredients and shape into 3 inch loaf... place in baking pan or small roaster. Bake 20 minutes in covered pan, baste with drippings, lower fire and bake 50 minutes, basting every 10 minutes.

- 1 cup cracker crumbs
- 6 pimientos
- 1 small onion, diced
- 1 cup mayonnaise
- 2 tablespoons gelatin.

Soak gelatin in 1/2 cup of cold water. Dissolve in 1 cup hot water. Add remaining ingredients to gelatin mixture when cool. Serve on lettuce or watercress and top with strips of pimiento.

Salmon Casserole

Combine one 1 pound can of red salmon, 1 cup clam chowder, 1 cup rice flakes, 1 egg, 1/2 teas. salt and a dash of pepper, and mix thoroughly. Place in a buttered casserole and bake in a hot oven (400 degrees F) for 30 minutes. Buttered rice flakes may be sprinkled over top before baking if desired.

Broiled Sausage, with Welsh Rarebit

Twelve pork sausage links; 1 cup ale or beer; 1 pound cheese, grated; 1 egg; 1 tbs. Worcestershire sauce; pinch of dry mustard; dash of red pepper; 6 slices of toast. Broil sausages. Place in warm oven. Beat egg. Worcestershire sauce, mustard and pepper together. Heat ale or beer in chafing dish. Add cheese gradually, stirring constantly. When cheese is melted, thoroughly, add egg mixture. Stir until well blended. Place two sausages on each piece of toast and cover with the rarebit. Serves 6.

Household Hints

Modern household gadgets have contrived fewer mishaps for the cook to mourn over than in other days. But just so long as the telephone will ring when there's a pan of cookies in the oven or the small boy of the family comes in with wet shoes and stockings at the moment the vegetables are ready for buttering, there will be minor kitchen catastrophes.

The most common accident in every home is the boiling dry of saucepans in which vegetables are cooking. When this happens, turn the contents of the cooking pan immediately into a fresh pan and don't under any consideration scrape the burned pan. Usually the burned portion of the vegetable will stick to the pan and the part in the fresh pan will be all right. If you are using an aluminum pan, as soon as the vegetable has been transferred to the fresh pan, put the burned one in a large vessel of cold water, but put no water inside.

Enamel ware cannot be treated this way because the sudden change of temperature might ruin the enamel.

If cream is hard to whip add

some lemon juice. A pinch of salt added to cream before whipping is also effective. Cream whips easier if dish and beater are placed on ice until cold.

To cure a bee or wasp sting use common baking soda. For relief from wasp stings rub with slice of onion. For relief from bee stings apply moistened tobacco or a paste made of sale, soda and water.

For jammed fingers immerse the hand in water as hot as can be borne and rub vigorously. Bandage in sweet oil and vaseline.

When your sheets begin to wear, rip off the torn part and rehem the remainder. These smaller sheets may be used for cots for the children and also are valuable as draw sheets in case of illness.

When making tomato bisque dissolve a pinch of soda in the milk used in bisque and there will be less danger of it curdling.

When a potato is baked in its own skin the moisture in the potato supplies the steam that makes the texture of the vegetable soft and mealy, while preserving the flavor. And it's a simple way to prepare it.

Keep a toy magnet in your workbasket; then when you drop a needle, you can pick it up easily and quickly. If it seems lost, the magnet will even find it for you! If you keep a length of bright colored ribbon or tape attached to the magnet, it is easily distinguished in the basket or drawer.

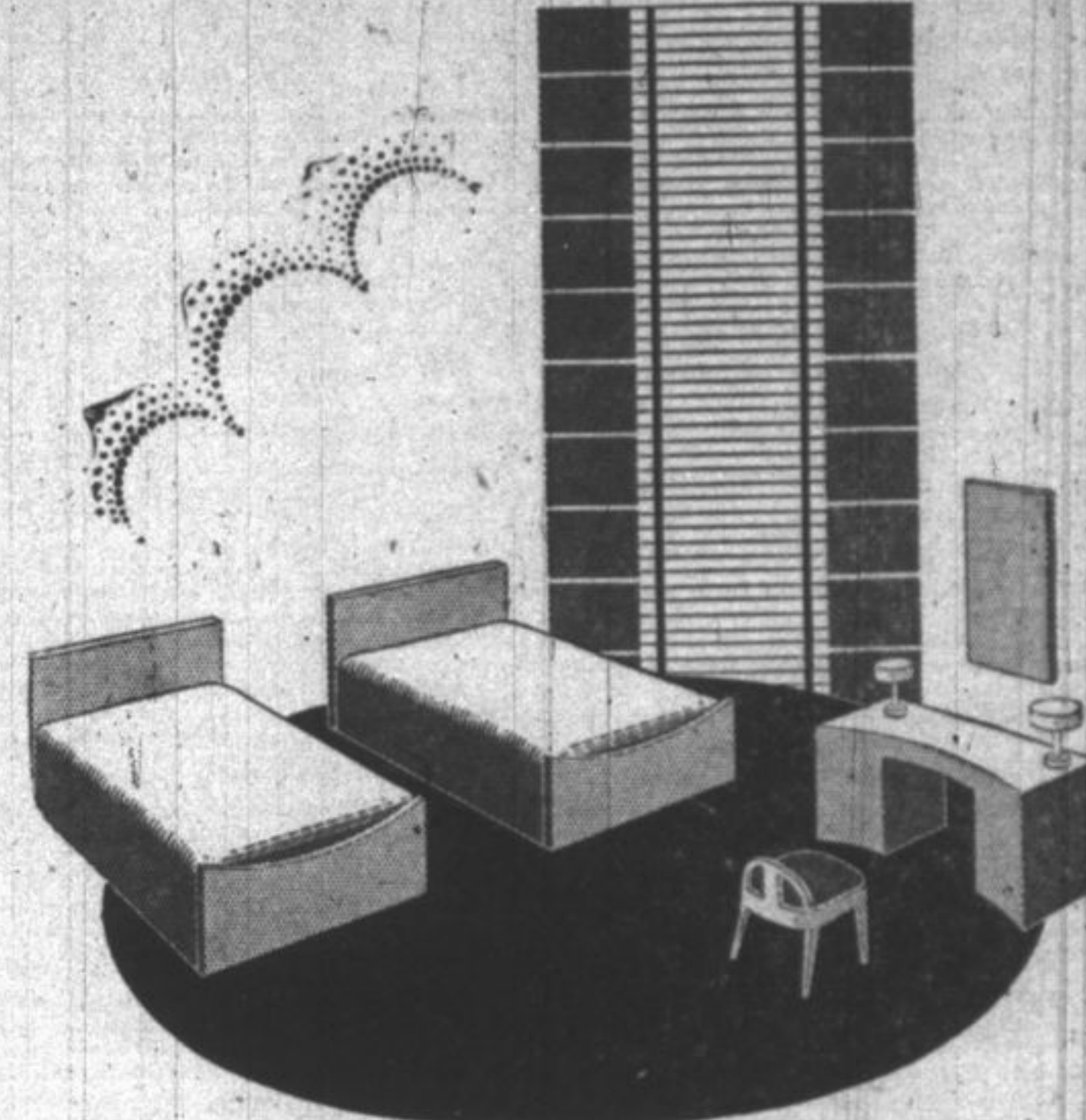

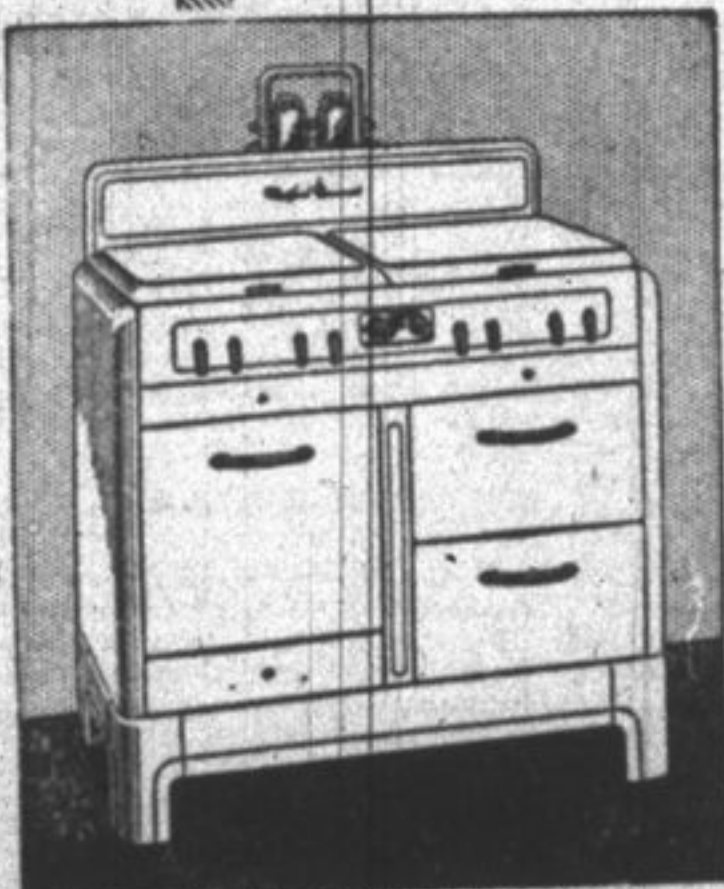
