Trailer Regulation Perplexes Many State Legislatures

Trailer regulation is one of the most complicated and difficult questions that will come up for consideration by numerous state legislatures in the months immediately ahead, Joseph H. Braun, general counsel of the Chicago Motor club, declared today.

"Already several municipalities have taken action against the trailers and court fights have resulted," Mr. Braun said, "In some cases, the trailer wheels have been removed, and the 'traveling bungalow' placed on brick or wood foundations which action, city officials claim, brings the trailer under the provisions of the building code.

"In Pontiae, Mich., a judge ruled that trailers must have at least four hundred feet of usable ground space and five hundred cubic feet space for each occupant.

"In Detroit, the board of health has ordered trailers to move off



Detroit parking lot on the groun that the trailers were unsanitary and unhealthful. An investigation has been ordered into possible fire hazards and other technical violations of the building code.

"The town council of Palm. Beach, Fla., has decreed stringent restrictions against trailers and refused authority for establishment of a trailer camp. Parking of trailers on the highway is limited to one hour. A proposal was advanced in the city of Washington to prohibit trailers from parking except long enough to load and unload but this suggestion met with strenuous opposition.

"Other questions, such as taxation, schooling of children, and so on are among the knotty problems that have been created by the evergrowing and peripatetic trailer population."
