NOTICE is hereby given that a public hearing will be held in the Council Chamber in the City Hall in the City of Highland Park, Illinois, on Tuesday, the 8th day of June, 1937, at eight o'clock P.M., which said public hearing will be conducted by the undersigned, the Zoning Committee for the City of Highland Park, designated and appointed by the Council of the City of Highland Park for that purpose to consider and make an ordinance entitled: "AN ORDINANCE Amending an Ordinance Entitled 'An Ordinance to regulate and limit the height and bulk of buildings; to regulate and limit the intensity of the use of lot areas, and to regulate and determine the area of open spaces within and surrounding each building; to classify, regulate, and restrict the location of trades and industries and the location of buildings designed for specified industrial, business, residential, and other uses; to divide the entire City of Highland Park into districts for the purpose of this ordinance; to fix standards to which buildings or structures shall conform; to prohibit uses, buildings, or structures incompatible with the character of such districts respectively; and to prevent additions to and alterations or remodeling of existing buildings or structures in such a way as to avoid the restrictions and limitations lawfully imposed hereunder, and to provide penalties for violation hereof, 'as amended' in the following manner: "As amended" in the following manner: It is proposed that Lots 14 and 15, Block 6, Northwood Manor Subdivision be changed from Class "C" Business to Class "B" Residence.
