Now, as to going around curves. Every one knows the old geometry theorem - a straight line is the shortest distance between two points -or something of that sort. That "shortest distance" seems to be the idea of most motorists when rounding a curve-make it as short as possible from one curb to the other no matter who or what may be in the way. Such a thing as cutting in front of another vehicle and endangering it and its occupants is of no consequence. Only the shortest way to get around.

"Wrong driving in turning corners or rounding a curve is not only violating the law, but isn't good form, it isn't courteouss and just isn't done by the best drivers," comments Carl A. Barrett, president of the Illinois Automobile club. "Some day the police will 'crack down' on these fellows-and what a lot of them there will be to 'crack. In the meantime, motorists can save themselves a lot of trouble if they will just remember that there are others on the road and show just a trifle of courtesy. Why be a


