

Hospital Care Plan Cautions Public Against Promoters

An announcement issued today by the board of directors, covering progress made by Plan for Hospital Care to date, directed the attention of the public to the fact that success of the Plan might inspire promoters in the organization of other so-called plans of group hospitalization which would not have even the tacit sanction of Chicago's leading hospitals.

"There are now," said Taylor Strawn, president of the board, "sixty-one contracted member hospitals in the plan, including practically all of the approved, general hospitals in the Chicago metropolitan area from Waukegan to Kankakee, and to the west, including Aurora and Elgin.

"All of our member hospitals have advised us that they give no recognition whatever, or any credit standing, to any other local organization offering hospital service to the public, or to the membership cards or identification cards of any such local group except Plan for Hospital Care.

Plan for Hospital Care is officially approved by the Association of Commerce and the American Hospital Association. Executives desiring independent information about the plan may inquire of these organizations or the Better Business Bureau. "The American Hospital Association has wisely decided that, for the best protection of public interest, any group hospitalization project should have, as contracted member hospitals, a majority of all approved hospitals in the area covered by such a plan," said Perry Adleman, executive director.

"Plan for Hospital Care makes contracts with no hospitals except those approved by the American Medical Association and the American College of Surgeons, and more than ninety per cent of all such hospitals in the entire Chicago area are now in the plan.

"As a further protection to commercial and industrial organizations and their employees desiring to enroll in Plan for Hospital Care, we have adopted a policy whereby our enrollment representatives solicit no individuals or groups until inquiries concerning the plan have been made at our offices at 105 S. LaSalle street. We have no canvassers or solicitors, and none of our employees
