Failure to Pass Reciprocity Bill Renews License War

Failure to pass a truck license reciprocity bill, which went through the Wisconsin state senate unanimously only to become lost in the closing rush of the state house, ended reciprocity in the matter of truck licenses between Illinois and Wisconsin, with the result that all Illinois truck drivers going into Wisconsin must have licenses from both states.

Attorney Grant Stevens of Madison, Wis., engaged by the American Trucking association, has been fighting the case before the Wisconsin Warehouse commission since the Wisconsin licenses became due on July 1. Then when the commission last Monday night ruled against further delays, Illinois trucking concerns were forced to pay the license fees for all their trucks operating in Wisconsin.

Frank Webber of the Webber Cartage company in Waukegan, one of the leading proponents of a reciprocity agreement between Illinois and Wisconsin, sped to Madison-yesterday with a certified check for \$4,-400 to buy Wisconsin licenses for his trucks that operate in Wisconsin in order that several of them, on trips in Wisconsin, would not be held up by the police.

Other local trucking concerns affected by the license war are Inter-State Motor Freight system, local branch of Keeshin Motor Express Co., North Shore Motor Express Co., Fred Olson and Son, Rause Motor Express, Roosevelt Cartage Co., S. and D. D. Transfer Co., and Stewart Cartage Co.

Wisconsin is now the only state in the Union, Webber states, that does not have a reciprocity agreement. As a consequence, trucks from other states must be licensed in Wisconsin as well as their home states and in addition, all Wisconsin trucks moving into any other state, must be licensed in the state in which they are traveling.

In addition to buying state licenses for Illinois trucks in Wisconsin, the owners must pay an additional mileage tax computed on the number of miles the out-of-state truck travels in Wisconsin.

Because the reciprocity agreement was ended abruptly by the Wisconsin Warehouse commission ruling, Secretary of State Edward J. Hughes of Illinois state police to enforce the payment of the Illinois license and mileage tax against all Wisconsin trucks moving in Illinois.

With the reciprocity measure by the Wisconsin senate, efforts are being made to have the Wisconsin legislature called into special session to permit the house to pass the bill and rush it to the governor for signature. As even a special session would require considerable time before the law could be approved, Illinois truckers were left no alternative but to buy the Wisconsin licenses for all trucks moving into the Badger state.
