

# Five Escape from Fort Prison Monday; Two Are Returned

364 North Av. Highland Pk.

Two of the five military prisoners at Fort Sheridan who knocked the guard house superintendent unconscious Monday night and escaped through a window were captured early Tuesday morning in Glencoe.

The men who were captured were Richard B. Carroll, 18 and Edward A. Swanson, 25 both of Chicago. The other three who are still at large are Lawrence B. Deacon, 24 years old, of Chicago: Harold Hensley, 23 of Shumway, Ill., and Richard Troy of Detroit- Mich. Carroll is under a 3 year prison sentence for desertion and robbery while the others wre awaiting trial for various offenses. Their daring break from the military prison was effected only a few hours before they were to have started for the Fed-

ral penitentiary at Leavenworth. Private Dick Curtin, 29, superintendent of the guard house, surprised the men just as they finished sawing through the bars. He was felled with a blow on the head from a bucket. The five then escaped through the window and fled.

Th two men were captured as they emerged from hiding in a woods, just as an army truck passed. They were captured by Corporal John P. Nichold and Private William Davis.

Capt. T. G. Holland, provost marshal at the Fort, attributed the escape to the noise and confusion of visitors at the Post on Labor Day.
