AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED, "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING AND RESTRICTING THE USE AND OPERATION OF USED CAR LOTS IN THE CITY OF HIGHLAND PARK, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS."

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIGHLAND PARK, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS: Section 1. DEFINITIONS. For the purpose of this Ordinance, the following definitions shall prevail: A USED CAR LOT is any lot, plot or parcel of land, vacant or improved, where one or more used motor vehicles of whatever description are stored, kept for sale or trade or otherwise, by any person, firm or corporation.

Section 2. APPLICATION. That no person, firm or corporation shall operate or maintain a used car lot in the City of Highland Park unless and until proper application be made to the City Council, and approved therefor.

Section 3. LICENSE FEE. That the annual license fee to operate a used car lot shall be One Hundred and no/100 Dollars (\$100.00), and tendered in cash or certified check with the application, and which said license is granted, will be accepted in payment of said license for one year from the date thereof.

Section 4. RESTRICTIONS. That it shall be unlawful to store, park, or keep for sale or otherwise, any used motor vehicle except that which is in good running and safe operating condition and as defined by the Statutes of the State of Illinois, relating to Motor Vehicles. All of said motor vehicles shall be parked in an orderly fashion, allowing a space of not less than Ten (10) feet to be well lighted at night, and enclosed with a fence or other structure, and to be approved by the Building Inspector of the City of Highland Park. Said license shall further contain the ordinances of said City and laws of the State of Illinois relating to fire regulations and sanitation. No motor vehicle shall be repaired or dismantled thereon and said lot shall be subject to Police Inspection at such times as is deemed necessary.

Section 5. LOCATION - FRONTAGE CONSENTS. No person, firm or corporation shall locate, build, construct, operate or maintain any used car lot in the City of Highland Park without having first secured and filed with the City Clerk, the written consent of the owners or a majority of the owners of the frontage abutting on such street or streets within such block of the proposed used car lot.

The term "block" as used in this section shall be construed to include that portion of the street between the two intersections with other public street nearest the specified location on each side; provided that the width of each side of such block there is no such intersection within three hundred feet of the center of the specified location the block shall be construed as terminating at the point three hundred feet from such center. The term "street" as used in this section shall be construed to mean and include all highways as have been dedicated by either common law or statutory dedication as public streets and are actually in use as such; and the term "street" shall not be construed to include or mean merely service highways which are commonly known as alleys.

Frontage consent once secured and filed shall not be withdrawn. Section 6. PENALTY. Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this ordinance shall be fined not less than separate offense shall be deemed committed one dollar (\$1.00) nor more than two hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for each offense; and a separate offense shall be deemed committed on each and every day during or on which a violation occurs or continues.

Section 7. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed. This ordinance shall be in full approval and adoption according to law. CHAS. PORTILIA Mayor.

Five Escape from Fort Prison Monday; Two Are Returned Two of the five military prisoners at Fort Sheridan who knocked the guard house superintendent unconscious Monday night and escaped through a window, were captured early Tuesday morning in Glencoe.

The men who were captured were Richard B. Carroll, 18 and Edward A. Swanson, 25 both of Chicago. The other three who are still at large are Lawrence B. Deacon, 24 years old, of Chicago; Harold Hensley, 23, of Shumway, Ill., and Richard Troy of Detroit, Mich. Carroll is under a 3 year prison sentence for desertion and robbery while the others were awaiting trial for various offenses. Their daring break from the military prison was effected only a few hours before they were to have started for the Federal penitentiary at Leavenworth.

Private Dick Curtis, 29, superintendent of the guard house, surprised the men just as they finished sawing through the bars. He was felled with a blow on the head from a bucket. The five then escaped through the window and fled.

The two men were captured as they emerged from hiding in a woods, just as an army truck passed. They were captured by Corporal John P. Nichol and Private William Davis.

Capt. T. G. Holland, provost marshal at the Fort, attributed the escape to the noise and confusion of visitors at the Post on Labor Day.
