CHRISTIAN SCIENCE CHURCHES

"God the Preserver of Man" was the subject of the Lesson-Sermon in all Churches of Christ, Scientist, on Sunday, December 12.

The Golden Text was, "The Lord shall deliver me from every evil work, and will preserve me unto his heavenly kingdom: to whom be glory for ever and ever" (II Timothy 4:18).

Among the citations which comprised the Lesson-Sermon was the following from the Bible: "The Lord is good to all; and his tender mercies are over all his works. The eyes of all wait upon thee; and thou givest them their meat in due season. Thou openest thine hand, and satisfiest the desire of every living thing. The Lord preserveth all them that love him" (Psalms 145: 9, 15, 16, 20).

The Lesson-Sermon also included the following passages from the Christian Science Textbook: "Science and Health with Key to the Scriptures," by Mary Baker Eddy: "God is not influenced by man. The 'divine ear' is not an auditory nerve. It is the all-hearing and all-knowing mind, to whom each need of man will be supplied" (p. 7).
