

Meeting Called To Vote On School Board Postponed

Last week the Deerfield Press announced the possibility of a Board of Education for Deerfield Grammar School District 109, when at a meeting on February 14 in accordance with the proposition, Mr. C. W. Boyle, president of the board of directors, recommended that a survey be made to determine whether or not District 109 could fulfill the requirements for a Board of Education.

According to those interested in

the situation many steps have been taken in the past few years to create a board of education to replace the present system of regulation under a board of directors, but no real action resulted until Mr. Raymond Meyers, was recently elected as a member of the board of directors. In his campaign previous to election Mr. Meyers advocated the change of policy, due to his knowledge of school conditions in the village. Mr. Meyers has resided in Deerfield all his life and is a graduate of the grammar school, of Deerfield-Shields high school and studied mechanical engineering at Lewis Institute for two years.

The following communication regarding the postponement of a meeting called for Monday evening, Feb. 28th, has been received by The Press. The Press remains neutral on all questions of politics.

"Board of Education for District 109? Your guess is as good as Ours!"

The special meeting called for Monday evening, Feb. 28, to vote on this important question was postponed by President C. W. Boyle shortly before meeting time.

This seems an unusual procedure in view of the fact that directors

The directors should not delay so long that this important matter cannot be voted in accordance with legal requirements, is a warning voiced by those who advocate the seven-member board of education.

born at Barrington, Ill., and has lived there all his life. He is married and has two children, a son, Royland, seventeen years old, who is a student at Illinois University, and a daughter, Phyllis Jean, 14 years old, who is a sophomore in the Barrington high school.

He has been one of the leading farmers near Barrington, Lake County, owning and operating his own farm.

Mr. Kelsey is a member of the Board of the Barrington school district of which he was elected when he was 21 years old and has served in that capacity continuously ever since. He has been very active in all civic activities and clubs in his home community.

In 1928 Kelsey was elected a member of the County Board of

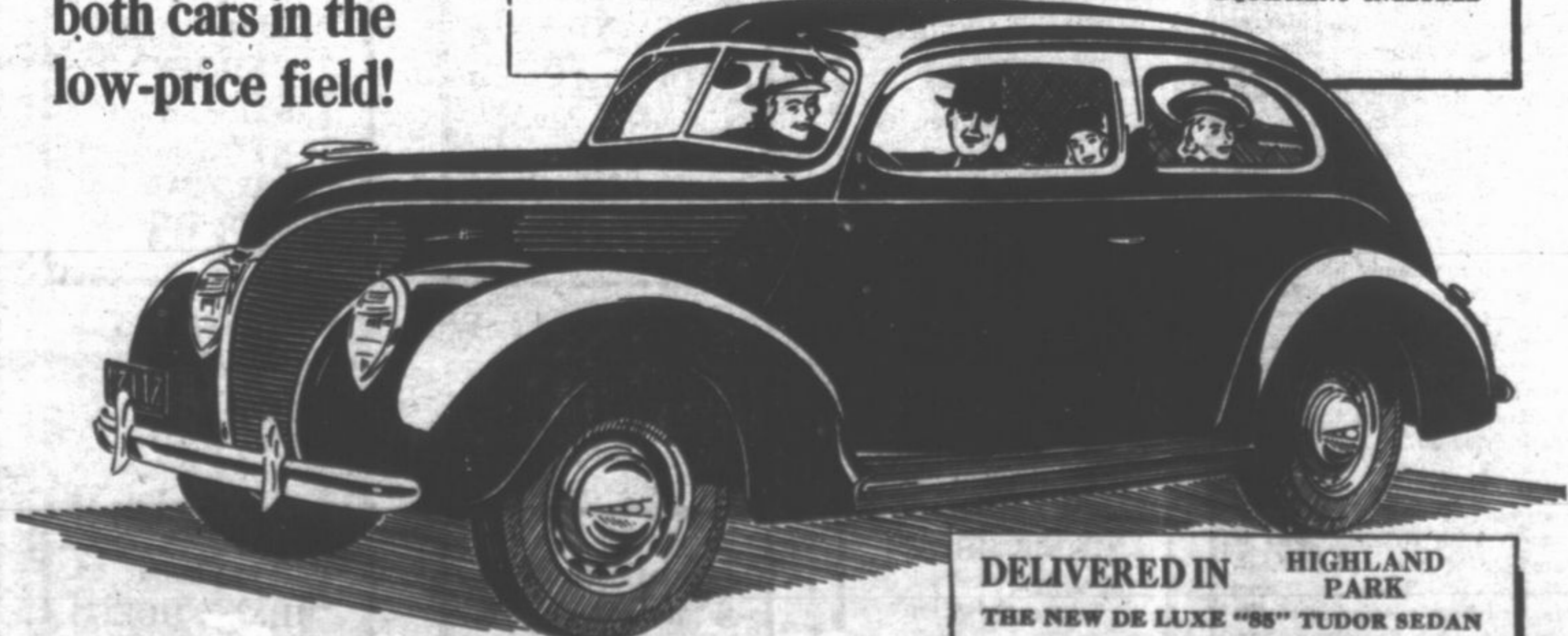
