

### Agnes Davis Makes First Appearance On North Shore

When Dr. Frederick Stock opens the twenty-sixth annual Music Festival in Northwestern's Gymnasium Tuesday evening, May 17, he will bring to Evanston a galaxy of artists, many of whom are appearing here for the first time. Among the newcomers who have had outstanding successes elsewhere is Agnes Davis, brilliant soprano who was

born in Denver. Miss Davis will appear on the programs of the first two nights of the festival, singing in the "King David" and "Requiem" in addition to performing a number of operatic arias alone and in duet with Miss Castagna and Mr. Crooks.

Miss Davis comes from a family combining the military and musical. The youngest of four daughters, she inherited from her Huguenot

mother a great musical talent which her Army Colonel father belatedly recognized. Studying to be a teacher of physical culture, Miss Davis took a chance and entered the nationwide Atwater-Kent contest in 1927. To her own surprise she won the \$5,000 prize and became a celebrity overnight.

Operatic and orchestra engagements followed in quick succession. With a beautiful lyric-dramatic voice, she can sing practically anything. Last season she won added laurels in such contrasting operas as "Falstaff," "Rosenkavalier" and "Haensel and Gretel". With many of the outstanding orchestras of the country she has sung music ranging from Handel's "Messiah" and Mahler's Second Symphony to concert excerpts from Wagner's many operas. Stokowski and other famed conductors have engaged her repeatedly. This year in addition to sole engagements, she is touring with Metropolitan tenor, Charles Hackett in programs of "Love Scenes from Famous Romantic Operas."

Her first aria in Evanston will be Wagner's "Dich Tuere Halle" to be heard Tuesday night, May 17.
